Re: *UGI Utilities Inc. – Electric Division Request for Approval of Alternative Energy Portfolio Standards Act Request for Proposal Solicitation (RFP) Results for the February 2026 AECs RFP, Docket No. P-2024-3049343*

To Parties of Record:

On June 9, 2026, UGI Utilities Inc. – Electric Division (UGI) filed a Petition to Modify its Default Service Supplier Master Agreement and Seeking Expedited Commission Action (Petition to Modify). The request for relief clause in UGI’s Petition to Modify seeks final Commission action by June 26, 2026.

Unless a different time is prescribed by the Commission, answers to petitions shall be filed with the Commission within 20 days after the date of service. 52 Pa. Code § 5.61. Accordingly, based on UGI’s certificate of service date, any answers to the Petition to Modify would be due June 29, 2026.

Because UGI averred that “UGI has advised the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement, the OCA, the OSBA and all other parties that participated in the Company’s most recent default service proceeding of this Petition. All of these parties have indicated that they have no objection to this Petition[,]”<sup>1</sup> and in order to assure due process to all parties within the requested expedited review period, the Commission is setting a 10-day period in which any party may file an answer to the Petition to Modify or, in the alternative, a letter confirming it does not oppose the Petition to Modify. The 10-day response period will run from the date of this Secretarial Letter.
