Respondent:

On March 3, 2026, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement instituted a Complaint at C-2026-3059929 against READING CITY CAB LLC, Respondent, alleging that:

- a. Taxi was being operated in Dauphin County while Respondent's authority is for Berks and Lancaster Counties only, violating 66 Pa. C.S. §§1102(a)(1), §3310. The penalty for this violation is \$500.
- b. Taxi failed to display Respondent's name and associated PUC certificate of convenience number, as the name and number were that of a cancelled taxi authority, violating 52 Pa. Code §29.71(a). The penalty for this violation is \$50.
- c. The wheel nut/bolt for the front, drivers side tire was missing, violating 52 Pa. Code §29.402(1); 67Pa. Code§175.80(e)(1)(xii). The penalty for this violation is \$100.
- d. Taxi failed to display consumer information decal, the consumer information decal identified a carrier other than Respondent, violating 52 Pa. Code §29.318. The penalty for this violation is \$50.
- e. Driver was smoking in vehicle upon inspection, violating 52 Pa. Code §29.403(10). The penalty for this violation is \$250.

In accordance with 52 Pa. Code §5.61, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement notified the Respondent that an Answer to the Complaint must be filed within twenty (20) days of the date of service. The Notice further specified that, if Respondent failed to answer the Complaint within twenty (20) days, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement would request that the Commission to issue a letter fining Respondent the sum of nine hundred fifty dollars (\$950.00).

The Complaint was mailed by certified mail, March 4, 2026. On April 18, 2026, the Complaint was published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*. To date, more than twenty (20) days later, no response has been received from Respondent.

Respondent is assessed a fine of \$950.00 for failure to comply with the provisions of 66 Pa. C.S. 1501 and 52 Pa. Code. Payment must be made by certified check or money order payable to the Commonwealth of PA, and mailed to Pa. Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120.

Respondent is hereby notified to cease and desist from further violations of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. §§1.1 et seq., and the regulations of the Commission, 52 Pa. Code §§1.1 et seq.

APPEAL RIGHTS

If you disagree with this determination, you may send a Petition for Reconsideration from Staff Action (Petition) to: Secretary, PA Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120. Such a Petition is a written statement asking the Commission to change its determination.

ALL Parties to proceedings pending before the Commission are advised to open and use an e-filing account through the Commission's website. If a filing contains confidential or proprietary material, the filing is required to be submitted by overnight delivery.

The Petition must be filed with the Commission within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter. If no timely request for reconsideration is made, this action will be deemed to be the final action of the Commission.

The Petition MUST include: (1) a written statement (divided into numbered paragraphs) outlining the reasons for the request, (2) the case docket number(s) (they are provided for you at the top right-hand corner of this letter), (3) the name of the person on whose behalf the petition is made, (4) copies of relevant documentation, and (5) a verification with original signature. *See* 52 Pa. Code §§1.31 and 5.44. Below is a sample Verification:


