Dear Secretary Homsher:

The Office of Small Business Advocate (“OSBA”) submits this letter to inform the Public Utility Commission that it does not oppose the *Joint Petition for Settlement of the Section 1307(f) Rate Investigation* filed by the parties in the above-referenced proceeding. The OSBA filed a Complaint in this proceeding on March 5, 2026.

As set forth in the OSBA’s April 10, 2026, Prehearing Memorandum, the OSBA reviewed the following issues set forth in the annual Purchased Gas Cost (“PGC”) Rate filing of Peoples Natural Gas Company LLC (“PNG” or the “Company”):

- PNG’s lost and unaccounted-for gas levels;
- PNG’s proposed modification to the tariff retainage amount paid;
- the Company’s design day demand forecasting and peak day capacity requirements;
- the Company’s gas supply procurement and Wagner Adjustment proposals;
- PNG’s decision to not implement a hedging program;
- the Company’s transportation customer retainage rate;
- the Company’s producer retainage rate;
- the Company’s recovery of under-collections;
- the Company’s recovery of pipeline overrun charges; and
- PNG’s method for handling supplier refunds.

The OSBA also engaged in settlement discussions with PNG and the other parties. The OSBA did not identify any aspects of the issues, set forth above, that were unjust or unreasonable to small business customers. Therefore, this letter serves as formal notice that the OSBA does not

oppose the *Joint Petition for Settlement of the Section 1307(f) Rate Investigation* filed by the other parties.
