Dear Secretary Homsher:

The Office of Small Business Advocate (“OSBA”) submits this letter to inform the Public Utility Commission that it does not oppose the *Joint Petition for Settlement of Rate Investigation Pursuant to 66 Pa.C.S. §1307(f)* filed by the parties in the above-referenced proceeding. The OSBA filed a Complaint in this proceeding on March 31, 2026.

As set forth in the OSBA’s April 1, 2026, Prehearing Memorandum, the OSBA reviewed the following issues set forth in the annual Purchased Gas Cost (“PGC”) Rate filing of Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Inc. (“Columbia” or the “Company”):

- Columbia’s lost and unaccounted-for gas rates;
- the Company’s gas price hedging strategy;
- the Company’s design day demand forecasting and peak day capacity requirements;
- the Company’s gas supply mix and strategy for basin diversification; and
- Columbia’s strategy for capacity release and off-system sales

The OSBA also engaged in settlement discussions with Columbia and the other parties. The OSBA did not identify any aspects of the issues, set forth above, that were unjust or unreasonable to small business customers. Therefore, this letter serves as formal notice that the OSBA does not oppose the *Joint Petition for Settlement of Rate Investigation Pursuant to 66 Pa.C.S. §1307(f)* filed by the other parties.
