5. Please state the number of drivers you intend to use or hire in your business and explain why that number of drivers is appropriate for the size of the territory you will be serving. In addition, please explain:
  - a. Your hiring standards for drivers;
  - b. Your system for conducting criminal background checks;
  - c. Your driver training program;
  - d. Your system for conducting driver's license checks;
  - e. Your policies regarding alcohol and drug use by your drivers.

As of right now, Miro's PA Transportation LLC has about 5-6 drivers on average, in the Altoona Office. We intend to have 5-6 more, once we have permission to open a new location in Westmoreland County, where in total we plan to have a total of 11-12 drivers total. So far and continuing, the hiring process takes about 1-2 weeks. Drivers must be AT LEAST 21 years of age. A background check is done through NES (National Employment Screening). During the first two weeks, also a driver's license check is done through the Department of Transportation website. Once all the checks are completed, a drug test is also completed through Quest Diagnostics. Once those results are good to go, we proceed with the second part of the hiring process by making sure the driver is good with SAMS, OFAC (Office of Foreign Assets Control), ensuring there is no record on the Sex Offender list, and that their name does not appear on the OIG website either. This process spans approximately an hour to an hour and half, and if

their name is clear, we then proceed with training. The training consists of them getting their First Aid and CPR certification and guaranteeing that they take their P.A.S.S test and completing the driver's safety test through the Ctaa.org website. All of this is conducted prior to a candidate's being able to drive. Once a driver is clear and passes all their training, a one day training day with a senior driver takes place before they can navigate a vehicle on their own, to verify and ensure safety with members, especially with wheelchair members.

Once a driver is hired, CTS (Coordinated Transportation Solutions); the brokers that we are contracted with for the Non-Emergency Medical trips, does the SAMS, SEX Offender checks, OFAC and OIG checks annually. Additionally, Miro's Pa Transportation confirms it yearly, sometime in January. The timing of the driver's hiring is inconsequential, when double checking SAMS, SEX Offender, OFAC and OIG. Along with this, the driver's license check and background check are also completed by the end of January of every year to make sure that all the paperwork and background checks are uniform. The testing for the CTAA.Org, the First Aid and CPR certifications get done on a biennial basis to ensure that they are never on the road with expired certifications.

In the case that the FIRST background check/ driver's license comes back with a negative notation the driver will be questioned and unfortunately not be hired, and if anything comes up AFTER the first year's check then said driver will be automatically questioned and fired.

Drug test we do to start the day of hire. And then every year or when requested by CTS. In case of an accident, a drug test is required per driver, per incident.
