The Office of Small Business Advocate (“OSBA”) files this letter in support of the June 5, 2026, *Joint Request for Extension of Public Comment Period*, filed by the Coalition for Affordable Utility Services and Energy Efficiency in Pennsylvania (CAUSE-PA) and the Tenant Union Representation Network (TURN) requesting an extension to the Comment deadline of July 29, 2026, and Reply Comment deadline of August 28, 2026, in the above-referenced matter.

The OSBA has conflicting deadlines during the existing Public Comment periods.
