Good afternoon, Judge Vero,

I am one of the attorneys representing UGI Electric and UGI Gas (collectively, "UGI") in the proceedings at Docket Nos. C-2025-3056200 and C-2025-3056208. I am writing regarding the evidentiary hearing that is scheduled for Wednesday, October 22, 2025 in these proceedings. I have a conflicting commitment on this date, as do the other attorneys for UGI who would be able to fill in in my stead.

As such, UGI respectfully requests that the scheduled evidentiary hearing be cancelled and rescheduled for a later date that works for both parties. UGI notes that this is the first

continuance request in this proceeding and that the request is being submitted more than 5 days before the scheduled hearing, in accordance with the Prehearing Order issued on August 28, 2025.

I attempted to communicate with Ms. Bedford regarding the Company's need to reschedule the hearing, but was unable to reach her. As such, I do not know whether the Complainant opposes this request.

If Your Honor would like UGI to reduce this request to a formal written motion, the Company can certainly do so.
