Application of the Department of Transportation of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for approval to alter the public at-grade crossing (DOT 506 378 J) by the installation of new active traffic control devices on Struble Road (T-380) and upgrading the highway traffic signals at the intersection of Struble Road and College Avenue (State Route 0026) with railroad preemption where Struble Road, crosses a track of the SEDA-COG Joint Rail Authority, operated thereon by Nittany and Bald Eagle Railroad, in College Township, Centre County all in accordance with the Federal Grade Crossing Program and the allocation of costs incident thereof.

To Whom It May Concern:

By amended Secretarial Letter dated June 23, 2021, and modified by Secretarial Letter dated October 3, 2023, we directed the alteration of the subject crossings to be completed on or before June 30, 2025.

By petition received on May 21, 2026, Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (Department) requests an extension of time in which to complete the project to November 30, 2027, because the traffic signal work is unfinished.

We have carefully reviewed the record in this proceeding and will grant the Department's petition for an extension of time to November 30, 2027.

THEREFORE:

The letter-petition received on May 21, 2026, by Pennsylvania Department of Transportation be and is hereby granted to the extent herein directed:

1. Paragraph 16 of our amended Secretarial Letter dated June 23, 2021, and modified by Secretarial Letter dated October 3, 2023, which reads as follows, to wit:

“16. All work necessary to complete the alteration of the subject crossing be done in a manner satisfactory to this Commission on or before June 30, 2025, and that on or before said

date, Pennsylvania Department of Transportation report the date of actual completion of the work.”
be and is hereby modified to read:

16. All work necessary to complete the alteration of the subject crossing be done in a manner satisfactory to this Commission on or before November 30, 2027, and that on or before said date, Pennsylvania Department of Transportation report the date of actual completion of the work.

2. In all other respects, our amended Secretarial Letter dated June 23, 2021, remains in full force and effect.

The Parties are reminded that failure to comply with this or any Order or Secretarial Letter in this proceeding may result in an enforcement action seeking civil penalties and/or other sanctions pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. § 3301.

All formal documents must be filed with the Secretary of the Commission. Documents must be eFiled, mailed or hand delivered. All filings should be addressed to the Secretary, PA Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120. The Commission will not accept documents delivered by fax or by e-mail. Parties are encouraged to file formal documents by eFiling with the Secretary of the Commission by opening an eFiling account through the Commission’s website (the account is free of charge) and accepting eservice at <https://www.puc.pa.gov/filing-resources/efiling/>.

If your filing contains confidential material, you are required to file by overnight delivery to ensure the timely filing of your submission. There are certain filings that cannot be eFiled, such as filings containing confidential or proprietary material. These must be submitted to the Secretary by overnight delivery, priority, or certified mail to allow tracking of your filing.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.31 and 5.44, file a Petition for Reconsideration from Staff Action (Petition) with the Commission within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter. The Petition shall be eFiled with the Secretary of the Commission or sent to: Secretary, PA Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120, and must be filed within twenty (20) days, or if no timely request is made, the action will be deemed to be a final action of the Commission.

The Petition MUST include: (1) a written statement (divided into numbered paragraphs) outlining the reasons for the request; (2) the case docket number (it is provided for you at the top right-hand corner of this letter); (3) the party on whose behalf the petition is made; (4) a Certificate of Service on the other parties of record; and (5) a Verification with original signature in accordance with 52 Pa. Code § 1.36.
