**MOTION OF FIRSTENERGY PENNSYLVANIA ELECTRIC COMPANY  
FOR CONTINUANCE OF HEARING AND REQUEST FOR MEDIATION**

TO THE PENNSYLVANIA PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION:

FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company (“FE PA” or the “Company”) by and through its attorney, Tori L. Giesler, and pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b), hereby files this Motion for Continuance of the hearing currently scheduled for June 25, 2026. In support thereof, the Company avers as follows:

**I. BACKGROUND**

1. On or about April 13, 2026, Twilight Renewables, LLC (“Complainant”) filed a Formal Complaint with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) regarding net metering solar projects in Pennsylvania.

2. On April 14, 2026, the Company was electronically served with the Formal Complaint by the Secretary’s Bureau of the Commission.

3. On May 4, 2026, the Company filed its Answer denying the material allegations and requesting that the matter be set for mediation.

4. On May 14, 2026, an Initial Telephonic Hearing Notice was issued and Administrative Law Judge Charese Z. Collins (“ALJ Collins”) issued a Prehearing Order setting an initial telephonic hearing date of June 25, 2026.

5. Later that same day, Counsel for the Complainant contacted Counsel for the Company stating that he concurred with the Company’s request to pursue mediation of the Formal Complaint, rather than moving forward with a hearing at this time.

6. As such, the Company respectfully requests that the hearing scheduled for June 25, 2026, in this matter be continued and the Parties be directed to attempt to mediate in an effort to resolve the Formal Complaint.

**II. MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE**

7. The Commission’s regulations permit a request for continuance of a hearing upon good cause shown.<sup>1</sup>

8. In this case, the Parties are jointly seeking a continuance in order for the Parties to have the opportunity to meaningfully mediate and attempt to resolve the Formal Complaint.

9. The Commission’s policy is to encourage settlements.<sup>2</sup>

10. The parties have both agreed that a continuance of the hearing currently scheduled for June 25, 2026, is in the best interests of judicial economy for the Commission as well as both parties.
