Request for Information

- 1.) Regarding question 10 of the application, if the language “ambulatory, wheelchair and stretcher” are written into the authority, you must have that equipment available from the date of certification. Do you have vehicles to accommodate wheelchairs and stretchers right now? Please provide evidence of those vehicles, or be prepared to provide evidence before you can be certificated. That language is not necessary in a territory.
- 2.) The territory you have designated that you are applying for, in some cases, is an extremely long distance from your stated physical location in Harrisburg. How do you intend to provide safe and efficient services in distant locations in Berks and Montgomery Counties from your base of operations in Harrisburg. Do you have satellite locations that you work from?
- 3.) The responses to questions 5(a), 5(b), 5(c), 5(d) and 5(e) of the verified statements are insufficient. Title 52 Pa. Code § 29 provides detailed requirements. **Please provide a system which incorporates code specified compliance requirements – those specific requirements are stated clearly in the Title, please look them up and provide specific answers to these questions.** Each of your answers to sections of this question were insufficient:
 - § 29.503. Age restrictions.
 - § 29.504. Driver history
 - § 29.505. Criminal history.
- 4.) Please provide evidence that your new company is funded. This can be a bank statement or similar.
