Re: Rulemaking to Further Amend the Provisions of 52 Pa. Code Chapter 56

The Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (NOPR) Order, entered by the Public Utility Commission (PUC) on February 19, 2026, established a 60-day comment period and 30-day reply comment period. The NOPR was published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* on May 30, 2026, at 56 Pa.B. 3136, resulting in a due date of July 29, 2026 for comments and August 28, 2026 for reply comments.


On June 5, 2026, The Coalition for Affordable Utility Services and Energy Efficiency in Pennsylvania (CAUSE-PA) and the Tenant Union Representation Network (TURN) requested an additional 45 days to file comments. On June 12, 2026 the Office of Small Business Advocate filed a letter in support of the request. The Energy Association of Pennsylvania filed a letter clarifying the requested extension dates on June 16, 2026.

The PUC grants the extension request and the due date for comments is hereby changed to August 28, 2026 with reply comments due by October 13, 2026¹.

¹ The 15-day extension requested by CAUSE-PA and TURN for reply comments falls on October 12, 2026, which is a holiday, so pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.12 the reply comments are due October 13, 2026.

Notice of this change will be published in the Pennsylvania Bulletin and provided to, among others, the Independent Regulatory Review Commission.
