In Re: A-2026-3062724 – Application of United Family Home Care Inc, for the right to begin to transport, in Paratransit service, between points in Bucks, Delaware, Montgomery and Philadelphia County.

To Whom It May Concern:

The purpose of this Letter is to advise you that your application for authority at Docket No. A-2026-3062724 has been **DENIED** by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission). The Commission has determined that a Certificate of Public Convenience shall not be granted for the following reason(s):

- Applicant is exempt from Commission regulations. Based upon the Application that was filed with the Commission, it has come to our attention that the proposed service is exempt from Commission regulation because it has been determined that the service that the applicant wishes to provide is considered incidental to their primary business. In response to our data request, United Family Home Care Inc stated that they will only be transporting individuals and future clients under their care and will not be providing transportation to the general public. For this reason(s), your application is **DENIED** and **DISMISSED**.

APPEAL RIGHTS

If you disagree with this determination, you may send a Petition for Reconsideration from Staff Action (Petition) to: Secretary, PA Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120. Such a Petition is a written statement asking the Commission to change its determination.

ALL Parties to proceedings pending before the Commission are advised to open and use an e-filing account through the Commission's website, OR you may submit your filing by mail. If a filing contains confidential or proprietary material, the filing is required to be submitted by mail.

The Petition must be filed with the Commission within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter. If no timely request for reconsideration is made, this action will be deemed to be the final action of the Commission.

The Petition MUST include: (1) a written statement (divided into numbered paragraphs) outlining the reasons for the request, (2) the case docket number(s) (they are provided for you at the top right-hand corner of this letter), (3) the name of the person on whose behalf the petition is made, (4) copies of relevant documentation, and (5) a verification with original signature. See 52 Pa. Code §§1.31 and 5.44. Follows is a sample Verification:
