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1 **SUPPLEMENTAL DIRECT TESTIMONY OF BLERINA GABA-TEME**

2 **I. INTRODUCTION**

3 **1. Q. Please state your name and business address.**

4 A. My name is Blerina Gaba-Teme. My business address is PECO Energy Company,
5 2301 Market Street, Philadelphia, PA 19103.

6 **2. Q. Are you the same Blerina Gaba-Teme who filed Direct Testimony in this**
7 **proceeding?**

8 A. Yes.

9 **3. Q. What is the purpose of your Supplemental Direct Testimony?**

10 A. A piece of testimony regarding PECO's evaluation of participation in pipeline open
11 seasons was inadvertently omitted from my previously filed Direct Testimony.
12 There are no other changes to my Direct Testimony at this time.

13 **II. PECO'S NATURAL GAS PURCHASE POLICIES AND PRACTICES**

14 **4. Q. You previously provided testimony on whether PECO has continued its**
15 **evaluation of participation in pipeline open seasons as a way of securing**
16 **additional cost-effective Firm Transportation to PECO's City Gate, do you**
17 **have any additional testimony to add?**

18 A. Yes. On September 17, 2025, Adelphia and PECO were able to come to terms with
19 a new FT contract available at the Lower Mud Run interconnection with Adelphia
20 and Transco/REA project in Adelphia's North Zone for 22, 500 dth/day. The
21 purpose of this new contract was to create one seamless transportation path
22 connecting Adelphia's North Zone with PECO's existing Adelphia South Zone
23 contract delivering into an existing PECO gate station in Chester, PA. Additionally,
24 this new contract on Adelphia allows PECO to source supply on Transco's REA

1 contract at the Leidy receipt point area located in the Marcellus Shale region. The
2 new contract ensures that gas being delivered at Chester, PA gate station, will be
3 received from a production area point. Previously, due to many regulatory
4 complications, due to the long approval process at FERC on Transco REA, it
5 became necessary to source gas from TETCO M3, in the Market Area, which
6 historically is much more costly than flowing gas from Transco Leidy.

7 The new North Zone contract has a ten-year term and ends in 2035. The existing
8 South Zone contract was extended at the same time and extends from the original
9 end date of 2032 to 2035. The North Zone contract will be a maximum rate
10 contract under the Adelphia tariff. The South Zone contract will remain at a
11 negotiated rate until 2032, when it converts to a maximum rate contract under
12 Adelphia's tariff.

13 **III. CONCLUSION**

14 **5. Q. Does this conclude your Supplemental Direct Testimony?**

15 A. Yes, it does.
