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**NEXTERA ENERGY TRANSMISSION MIDATLANTIC, INC.’S MOTION FOR  
LEAVE TO FILE ANSWER TO THE PETITION TO INTERVENE OF PHILLIP  
TARCY *NUNC PRO TUNC***

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**TO THE PENNSYLVANIA PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION:**

NextEra Energy Transmission MidAtlantic, Inc. (“NEET MA” or the “Company”) hereby files this Motion for Leave to File an Answer to the Petition to Intervene of Phillip Tarcy (“Petitioner”) *Nunc Pro Tunc* pursuant to Sections 1.2 and 5.103 of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission’s (“Commission”) regulations, 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.2 and 5.103, and respectfully requests that the Commission accept the Answer to the Petition to Intervene filed in

the above-captioned proceedings *nunc pro tunc*. NEET MA is filing the Answer concurrently with the instant Motion.

In support thereof, NEET MA avers as follows:

1. On March 3, 2026, NEET MA filed, pursuant to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code at 66 Pa.C.S. §§ 1101, 1103, and 2102, an application requesting all necessary authority, approvals, and certificates of public convenience from the Commission necessary to authorize NEET MA to begin to furnish and supply electric transmission service as a Pennsylvania public utility within Greene County and Fayette County, Pennsylvania (“CPC Application”).

2. Also on March 3, 2026, NEET MA filed, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 57.72, an application requesting Commission approval of the siting and construction of the Pennsylvania Portion of a new 500 kV transmission line associated with the MARL Project in Dunkard Township in Greene County and Springhill Township in Fayette County, Pennsylvania (“Siting Application”).

3. On March 26, 2026, Administrative Law Judge John M. Coogan issued a Prehearing Conference Order providing, among other things, that a Telephonic Prehearing Conference would be held on Wednesday, May 20, 2026 at 10:00 AM for both the CPC Application and Siting Application proceedings.

4. At the May 6 prehearing conference, Administrative Law Judges John M. Coogan and Erin L. Gannon (the “ALJs”) consolidated the CPC Application and the Siting Application.<sup>1</sup> The ALJs also decided that, for any protests and/or petitions to intervene filed on or before May 29, 2026, NEET MA would be permitted to respond on or before June 12, 2026.<sup>2</sup>

5. On June 11, 2026, the ALJs issued a Further Telephonic Prehearing Conference Notice, scheduling a second prehearing conference on Wednesday, July 29, 2026 at 10:00 AM.

6. On May 19, 2026, the Petition to Intervene of Phillip Tarcy was posted to one or both of the dockets in the above-captioned proceedings.

7. Pursuant to the directive of the ALJs, provided at the May 6 prehearing conference, NEET MA's response to the Petition to Intervene was due on or before June 12, 2026, because the Petition to Intervene was filed on or before May 29, 2026.

8. Due to an administrative oversight on the part of NEET MA, the Company is filing the Answer *nunc pro tunc* two business days beyond the deadline provided by the ALJs for filing of a responsive pleading.

9. The Company filed approximately 22 Preliminary Objections to Protests on June 12, 2026, and filed approximately 22 other Answers to Petitions to Intervene on June 12, 2026.

10. However, in the midst of filing and service of these numerous responsive pleadings, the Answer to the instant Petition to Intervene was inadvertently not filed or served.

11. NEET MA respectfully requests that the Commission accept the filing of NEET MA's Answer *nunc pro tunc*.

12. Chapter 1 of the Commission's regulations governs the rules of administrative practice and procedure before the Commission. *See* 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.1, *et seq.*

13. Section 1.2(a) states that the Commission's procedural rules in Title 52 shall be "liberally construed to secure the just, speedy, and inexpensive determination of every action or proceeding to which it is applicable." Further, the Commission's regulations state that the "Commission or presiding officer at any stage of an action or proceeding may disregard an error

or defect of procedures which does not affect the substantive rights of the parties.” 52 Pa. Code § 1.2(a).

14. Additionally, the regulation states that the “Commission or presiding officer at any stage of an action or proceeding may waive a requirement of this subpart when necessary or appropriate, if the waiver does not adversely affect a substantive right of a party.” *Id.*; *see also Info. Connections, Inc. v. Pa. PUC*, 630 A.2d 498, 501 (Pa. Cmwlth. 1993).

15. Here, the Petitioner’s substantive rights have not been affected in this dispute.

16. No evidentiary hearing has been scheduled in the matter yet, nor has the second prehearing conference occurred.

17. Accordingly, the Commission’s acceptance of NEET MA’s Answer *nunc pro tunc* would not unnecessarily delay the resolution of the Petition to Intervene.

18. Moreover, the Petitioner will be provided with a full and fair opportunity to participate in the proceedings.

19. For these reasons, NEET MA respectfully requests that NEET MA’s Answer be accepted for filing *nunc pro tunc*.

WHEREFORE, NextEra Energy Transmission MidAtlantic, Inc. respectfully requests that NEET MA's Answer to the Petition to Intervene of Phillip Tarcy be accepted for filing *nunc pro tunc*.
