
Dear Parties:

On March 27, 2026, Peoples Natural Gas Company LLC filed proposed Original Tariff Gas – Pa PUC No. 49 and Original Tariff Gas – Pa PUC No. S-5 seeking a change in its rates, rules, and regulations. On April 16, 2026, the Commission entered an Order suspending the proposed tariffs and instituted an investigation to determine the lawfulness, justness, and reasonableness of the rates, rules, and regulations contained in the proposed tariffs. This matter is still currently pending before the Commission.

On June 17, 2026, the Commission received a letter from Susan Robin, a Peoples Natural Gas Company customer. Ms. Robin's letter was addressed to Commission Chairman, Stephen DeFrank. Ms. Robin's letter contains statements and additional averments regarding the issues being litigated in the above-referenced case.

Because the subject matter of Ms. Robin's letter concerns the merits of a contested matter still pending before the Commission for final consideration, Ms. Robin's letter constitutes an ex parte communication prohibited by Section 334(c) of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code, 66 Pa.C.S. § 334(c). Accordingly, please be advised that, in order to cure the ex parte communication, I am placing Ms. Robin's Letter on the docket and serving a copy of this Secretarial Letter and Ms. Robin's letter on all the Parties of Record to this case.
