Re: Rulemaking to Review Cyber Security Self-Certification Requirements and the Criteria for Cyber Attack Reporting; Docket No. L-2022-3034353

Please be advised that a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (NOPR) was entered in the above-captioned proceeding on June 24, 2026, by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (PUC). The NOPR will be published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*, and comments may be filed at any time between the date of publication and 90 days following the date of publication. Reply comments may be filed during the 45-day period following the 90-day period for filing written comments. In summary, the NOPR proposes regulations requiring jurisdictional public utilities to report covered cybersecurity incidents and conform to specific standards and frameworks, namely the National Institute of Standards and Technology Cybersecurity Framework (NIST CSF), as well as maintain and adhere to specific evaluations, programs, and plans based on the number of customers each public utility serves. The proposed regulations also mandate each public utility to file annually with the PUC a certification that the public utility is compliant with the specified standards and requirements.
