PREHEARING CONFERENCE ORDER

You are receiving this order because you have been identified as a person who may have an interest in the proceedings filed with the Public Utility Commission listed in the captions above. This order will describe the process the Commission will follow in considering the Applications and Petition, the different options you may have for involvement, and how to become a party to these cases. There is no requirement that you participate; however, if you do not, then the cases will proceed and be decided without your input.

On April 6, 2026, PPL filed an Application with the Commission for approval to: (1) rebuild approximately 4.4 miles of the existing single-circuit Sunbury-Susquehanna #1 230 kV Transmission Line for double-circuit 230 kV operation (Susquehanna-Nescopeck #1 and #2 230 kV Transmission Lines) from the existing Susquehanna Switchyard to the proposed Nescopeck 230 kV Switchyard (Nescopeck Switchyard); (2) construct a new approximately 0.9-mile-long 230 kV transmission line tap for future 230 kV double-circuit operation (Sunbury-Nescopeck #1 230 kV Transmission Line) from the existing single-circuit Sunbury-Susquehanna #1 230 kV Transmission Line to the new Nescopeck Switchyard; (3) raise approximately 0.5 miles of the Sunbury-Susquehanna 500 kV Transmission Line to accommodate the undercrossing of the proposed Susquehanna-Nescopeck #1 and #2 230 kV Transmission Lines and the proposed Sunbury-Nescopeck #1 230 kV Transmission Line; and (4) construct a new 11.2-mile-long 230 kV transmission line (Sugarloaf 500/230 kV Transmission Line) for future double-circuit 500 kV capacity between the proposed Nescopeck Switchyard, new Tomhicken Switchyard, and the existing Harwood 230/69 kV Substation. This Application was filed at Docket No. A-2026-3061547.

Also on April 6, 2026, PPL filed: (1) a Petition for findings that a structure to shelter electrical and control equipment at the proposed Nescopeck Switchyard in Nescopeck Township, Luzerne County, Pennsylvania is reasonably necessary for the convenience or welfare of the public, at Docket No. P-2026-3061609; and (2) 30 Applications under 15 Pa.C.S. § 1511(c) for a finding and determination that the service to be furnished by the applicant through its proposed exercise of the power of eminent domain to acquire a certain portion of the lands of various entities in Hazle, Sugarloaf and Nescopeck Townships, Luzerne County, Pennsylvania,

for the Sugarloaf 500/230 kV Transmission Line project associated with the proposed Sugarloaf 500/230 kV Transmission Line project is necessary or proper for the service, accommodation, convenience, or safety of the public, at Docket Nos. The Prehearing Conference is for the discussion and planning of the litigation of the case. No testimony will be taken. Only attorneys representing parties of record and individual persons representing themselves as full litigants/a party of record will be permitted to participate in the Prehearing Conference.

In response to this Prehearing Order, you may proceed one of three ways:

Do nothing. If you do nothing after receiving this Prehearing Conference Order, your name will be removed from the service list. After the Prehearing Conference, you will not receive any pleadings, filings, discovery requests, written testimony or orders and decisions in this matter. You may still attend and testify at a public input hearing, if one is scheduled, as explained in the next paragraph.

Attend a public input hearing, if scheduled. Public input hearings, if scheduled, may be held in geographical areas impacted by the filings for the purpose of giving those who do not wish to participate in the formal litigation process an opportunity to express their opinions regarding PPL Electric's proposal. If public input hearings are scheduled, the Commission will issue a notice which includes instructions for how to tell the Commission that you wish to testify. If you testify at a public input hearing, you will not be permitted to testify at the evidentiary hearings. The Commission notice will also include instructions if you wish to listen but do not wish to testify. Notice of the public input hearings, if scheduled, will be published in your local newspaper two weeks prior to being held and on PPL Electric's website.

Become a party of record. As a party of record, you will be served with all the pleadings, filings, discovery requests, written testimony and orders and decisions served and issued in this proceeding. *These documents will be voluminous.* Your *rights* as a party of record include the ability to present your own testimony or documents and to cross-examine other witnesses at the formal hearings, and to file exceptions to the Administrative Law Judges' decision. Your *duties* as a party of record are that you must answer all discovery requests served upon you in accordance with the rules. You will be required to serve a copy of anything that you *file* upon the presiding officers and each party appearing on the service list, as modified after the Prehearing Conference, regardless of the cost of postage. If you intend to present evidence at the evidentiary hearings, you will be required to submit your testimony and documents in writing, in advance, and in accordance with the schedule to be set at the Prehearing Conference and to provide a copy of your written testimony to each party on the service list. You will be expected to participate in accordance with the rules of Commission practice appearing in Title 52 of the Pennsylvania Code (52 Pa. Code) at Chapters 1, 3 and 5. The Pennsylvania Code is available online at www.pacodeandbulletin.gov.

To become a party of record, you must file a formal protest or a petition to intervene. Formal protests and petitions to intervene must be filed in accordance with 52 Pa. Code (relating to public utilities) on or before **Friday, July 3, 2026**. All filings must be made with the

Secretary of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120, with a copy served on the undersigned and the current parties to this proceeding.¹

The undersigned presiding officers accept service via email to: efarren@pa.gov and sthaas@pa.gov. Email service to the presiding officers does not need to be followed by a hard copy unless specifically instructed.

The documents filed in support of the Application are available for inspection and copying at the Office of the Secretary between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, on the Commission's website at www.puc.pa.gov, and at the Company's business address.

You are strongly encouraged to register for the Commission's free e-Filing subscription service, which allows users to automatically receive an email notification whenever a document is added, removed, or changed on the Commission's website regarding a specific case. The parties are further directed to comply with the following requirements:

1. Each party must prepare and distribute a prehearing memorandum on or before **Wednesday, July 8, 2026**. Prehearing memorandum shall set forth a brief history of the

proceeding, the issues you intend to present, a list of your proposed witnesses and the subject of their testimony, a list of any exhibits or documents you intend to present at the hearing in this proceeding, the party's position² on public input hearings, and a proposed litigation schedule.

PPL Electric is expected to confer with Formal Protestants and attempt to agree to a proposed litigation schedule in advance of the Prehearing Conference.

Review the regulations pertaining to prehearing conferences, 52 Pa. Code §§ 5.221-5.224, particularly Section 5.222(d) which provides, in part:

(d) Parties and counsel will be expected to attend the conference fully prepared for a useful discussion of all problems involved in the proceeding, both procedural and substantive, and fully authorized to make commitments with respect thereto.

Review the regulations relating to discovery, specifically Section 5.331(b), which provides, *inter alia*, that “a party shall endeavor to initiate discovery as early in the proceedings as reasonably possible,” and Section 5.322, which encourages parties to exchange information on an informal basis. 52 Pa. Code §§ 5.331(b), 5.322. All parties are urged to cooperate in discovery and advise the presiding officers at the Prehearing Conference of discovery problems which have not been resolved. There are limitations on discovery and sanctions for abuse of the discovery process. 52 Pa. Code §§ 5.361, 5.371-5.372.

4. If you are an individual, you may represent yourself, or you may be represented by an attorney licensed to practice law in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or admitted pro hac vice. 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.21, 1.22. However, if you are a partnership, corporation, trust, association, or governmental agency or subdivision, you must be represented in this proceeding by an attorney licensed to practice law in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or admitted pro hac vice. Unless you are an attorney, you may not represent someone else. Attorneys shall enter her/his appearance in accordance with the provisions of Section 1.24(b), 52 Pa. Code § 1.24(b).

5. Failure of a party to attend the prehearing conference, or notify the presiding officers of the desire to fully participate without good cause shown, shall constitute a waiver of all objections to the agreements reached and matters decided at the prehearing conference, including, but not limited to, any special discovery rules and the litigation schedule established for this case. 52 Pa. Code §§ 5.222(e), 5.224.

6. You must serve the presiding officers directly with a copy, via email to efarren@pa.gov and sthaas@pa.gov, of any document that you file in this proceeding. If you send the undersigned any correspondence or document, you must send a copy to all other parties. For your convenience, a copy of the Commission's current service list of the parties to this proceeding is enclosed with this order.
