Dear Administrative Law Judges Coogan and Gannon,

On May 25, 2026, the Center for Coalfield Justice (CCJ) served NextEra Energy Transmission MidAtlantic, Inc. (NEET MA) with its First Set of Discovery Requests. NEET MA subsequently filed objections to those requests on June 5. On June 15, NEET MA produced documents in response to CCJ's requests without waiving its objections. Also on June 15, and before it was able to review NEET MA's production, CCJ filed a Motion to Compel Production of its Discovery Request, Set I, and Dismiss NextEra Energy Transmission MidAtlantic, Inc.'s Objections.

In subsequent discussions between counsel for NEET MA and CCJ, NEET MA has represented that it is not withholding any responsive documents based on its objections. CCJ

maintains both the legal arguments contained in its June 15 Motion to Compel and Dismiss Objections and maintains its First Set of Discovery Requests on a continuing basis. Based on representations of counsel that there are no withheld documents currently subject to the June 15 Motion to Compel, however, there are no outstanding disputes regarding production for Your Honors to resolve.
