Dear Parties:

On December 19, 2025, Applicant Filed a *Letter of Notification of PPL Electric Utilities Corporation Filed Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code Chapter 57 Subchapter G, for Approval to Build Approximately 1.1 Miles of New Parallel Double Circuit 230 kV Transmission Taps that are Needed to Connect the Existing Susquehanna-Harwood #1 & #2 Transmission Lines on the New Tomhicken 230 kV Switchyard that are Respectively Located in Luzerne County, Pennsylvania*. Because a decision has not yet been entered on the merits of the application, this matter is still currently pending before the Commission.

On June 12, 2026, the Commission received a letter from State Representatives Dane Watro, Jamie Walsh, and Joanne Stehr (Watro Letter). The Watro letter was addressed to the Commissioners of the Public Utility Commission. The Watro letter contains statements and additional averments regarding the issues litigated in the above-referenced case.

Because the subject matter of the Watro letter concerns the merits of a contested matter still pending before the Commission for final consideration, the Watro letter constitutes an *ex parte* communication prohibited by Section 334(c) of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code, 66 Pa.C.S. § 334(c). Accordingly, please be advised that, in order to cure the *ex parte* communication, I am placing the Watro Letter on the docket and serving a copy of this Secretarial Letter and the Watro letter on all the Parties of Record to this case.
