– Pa. P.U.C. No. 6; Compliance Filing

Dear Attorney Schultz:

On June 16, 2026, the City of Lancaster – Bureau of Water (the Company) filed Supplement No. 51 to Water – Pa. P.U.C. No. 6 to become effective on June 29, 2026. On June 29, 2026, the Company re-filed replacement pages to correct ministerial errors at the behest of Commission staff. Supplement No. 51 to Water – Pa. P.U.C. No. 6 was filed in compliance with the Commission’s Order entered June 4, 2026 at Docket No. R-2025-3057237, and authorizes the Company to allow increases in rates to collect \$4.7 million in total revenue, or an approximately 28.9% increase.

Commission Staff has reviewed the tariff revisions and found that suspension or further investigation do not appear warranted at this time. Therefore, in accordance with 52 Pa. Code Chapter 53, Supplement No. 51 to Water – Pa. P.U.C. No. 6 is effective by operation of law as of the effective date contained on each page of the supplement. However, this is without prejudice to any formal complaints timely filed against said tariff revisions.
