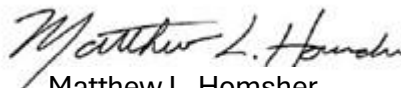
Dear Parties:

On March 27, 2026, UGI Utilities, Inc. – Electric Division (UGI) filed proposed Supplement No. 92 to UGI Electric Tariff – PA P.U.C. No. 6, containing proposed changes in rates, rules, and regulations to become effective June 1, 2026. The Office of Small Business Advocate and the Office of Consumer Advocate each filed a Formal Complaint against the rate case. Various oppositions to the rate case have also been filed. As the Commission has not yet entered a final order on the merits of this case, this matter is still currently pending before the Commission.

On July 1, 2026, the Commission received a letter from State Representative Jim Haddock. Representative Haddock's letter was addressed to Commission Chairman, Steven DeFrank. Representative Haddock's letter contains statements and additional averments regarding the issues being litigated in the above-referenced case.

Because the subject matter of Representative Haddock's letter concerns the merits of a contested matter still pending before the Commission for final consideration, Representative Haddock's letter constitutes an *ex parte* communication prohibited by Section 334(c) of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code, 66 Pa.C.S. § 334(c). Accordingly, please be advised that, in order to cure the *ex parte* communication, I am placing Representative Haddock's Letter on the docket and serving a copy of this Secretarial Letter and Representative Haddock's letter on all the Parties of Record to this case.
