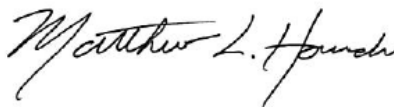

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Note: Please restate the data request prior to providing a response. In addition, provide the name and title of the person(s) providing the response and/or information for each data request.

- R-1. Fairview's additional supporting information, Section 5. Depreciation Schedule and Method, indicated that Fairview has a total original cost of \$80,261 excluding non-depreciable land. However, the filing indicates that the plant consists of station structures and improvements (\$49,915), other plant and miscellaneous equipment (\$23,003 and \$4,000), structures and improvements (\$2,343), and land and land rights (\$1,000, non-depreciable). These categories result in a total depreciable plant of \$79,261 ($\$49,915 + \$23,003 + \$4,000 + \$2,343 = \$79,261$), with the \$80,261 total original cost represented by Fairview appearing to include the \$1,000 of non-depreciable plant. These values are also supported by Fairview's 2025 annual report, Page 17. Please clarify if Fairview's total original cost of \$80,261, and its net utility plant as of December 31, 2025, of \$1,002, include the \$1,000 of non-depreciable land and land rights, as indicated on Fairview's 2025 annual report.
- R-2. Fairview's additional supporting information, Section 5. Depreciation Schedule and Method, indicated a claimed depreciation expense of \$1,002. Please provide justifications and supporting data for the service lives that Fairview used to calculate the accrued and annual depreciation for the assets claimed in the Tariff Supplement Filing.
- R-3. The Tariff Supplement Filing's Schedule C included customer count information that appears to be for years 2024 and 2025 in columns 1 and 2, respectively. However, the columns do not include dates that identify their corresponding year. Please identify the years that the customer counts in columns 1 and 2 represent.
- R-4. Fairview's additional supporting information, Section 2. Billing Analysis - Unmetered Residential Service, specified customer counts of 175 and 177 as of January 1, 2025, and December 31, 2025, respectively. However, Fairview's 2025 annual report, Page 37 identified a customer count of 177 as of both January 1, 2025, and December 31, 2025. Please explain this discrepancy and specify the customer count amounts as of January 1, 2025, and December 31, 2025.
- R-5. Fairview's proposed expense adjustments supporting narrative for Column L – Statements of Income, Section G specified total rate case expenses of \$60,000, including \$28,000 for rate case consulting and \$32,000 for rate case legal fees. Also, Fairview specified that these costs represent one-time expenses directly incurred in connection with the preparation, filing, and prosecution of this case. Please quantify Fairview's actual rate case expense incurred as of the date of Fairview's response to this data request.
- R-6. Please quantify Fairview's estimated total rate case expense if Supplement No. 18 does not receive a formal complaint.
- R-7. Please copies of Fairview's 2024 and 2025 federal income tax returns.

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- R-8. Please confirm that Fairview filed with the Commission its Public Utility Security Planning & Readiness Self Certification form for the 2026 calendar year.
