Dear Attorney Ryan:

By Opinion and Order entered June 11, 2026, the Commission authorized PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (the Company) to file tariff supplements containing the rates, rules, and regulations consistent with the Joint Petition for Non-Unanimous Settlement of All Issues filed in the above-docket, as modified by the Opinion and Order, and designed to produce additional annual operating revenues of not more than \$275 million. On June 30, 2026, the Company filed Tariff Supplement No. 2 to Electric Pa. P.U.C. No. 202 (Compliance Retail Tariff) and Tariff Supplement No. 2 to Electric Pa. P.U.C. No. 2S (Compliance Supplier Tariff) to become effective July 1, 2026.

Commission Staff has reviewed the tariff revisions and found that suspension or further investigation does not appear warranted at this time. Therefore, in accordance with 52 Pa. Code Chapter 53, the supplements are effective by operation of law as of the effective date contained on each page. However, this is without prejudice to any formal complaints timely filed against said tariff revisions.
