DSCI, LLC d/b/a TPx Communications (“TPx”) hereby provides notice, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.61, to the Pennsylvania Public Utilities Commission that TPx and its affiliates filed voluntary petitions for relief under chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of Texas on June 28, 2026, in Case No. 26-34547, commencing chapter 11 cases (the “Chapter 11 Cases”).

In Pennsylvania, TPx is authorized to provide resold local and long distance telecommunications services pursuant to authority granted by the Commission in Docket No. A-311343 and A-311343 F0002 on August 25, 2005, as assigned in Docket No. A-2014-2416619 on June 26, 2014.

The filing of the petitions served to convert the legal status of TPx and its affiliates to debtors-in-possession that will continue to operate their respective businesses during the court-supervised reorganization process. The filing did not result in any change to the current telecommunications services operations of TPx and it will continue to operate as before without any expected interruption to its customers in Pennsylvania. Furthermore, TPx will continue to comply with existing regulatory obligations and commitments. The reorganization of TPx and its affiliates through the bankruptcy process is expected to improve TPx’s financial and operational status to the benefit of its customers.

Should TPx’s future exit from Chapter 11 constitute a change of control requiring Commission approval, TPx will seek any necessary approval at that time.
