**ORDER
DIRECTING THE FILING OF SETTLEMENT DOCUMENTS**

UGI Gas is a natural gas distribution company with gross intrastate annual operating revenues in excess of \$40 million. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1307(f) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa.C.S. § 1307(f), and the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission’s (“Commission”) gas cost recovery regulations at 52 Pa. Code §§ 53.61-53.69, the Company initiated this annual proceeding to propose purchase gas cost (“PGC”) rates to become effective on December 1, 2026.

On May 1, 2026, the Company made its 30-day pre-filing with the Commission (containing data related to the recovery of purchased gas costs) pursuant to Section 1307(f) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa.C.S. § 1307(f), and in accordance with the Commission’s regulations at 52 Pa. Code §§ 53.64 and 53.65.

On May 7, 2026, the Office of Consumer Advocate (“OCA”) filed a Formal Complaint and Public Statement.

On May 8, 2026, the Commission’s Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement (“I&E”) filed a Notice of Appearance.

On May 15, 2026, the Office of Small Business Advocate (“OSBA”) filed a Notice of Appearance.

On June 1, 2026, UGI Gas filed its definitive PGC filing, including supporting information required by the Commission’s regulations, the Company’s direct testimony and exhibits and Pro Forma Tariff Supplement reflecting actual and projected changes in natural gas costs. UGI Gas is proposing a PGC rate of \$7.7727 per Mcf, effective December 1, 2026.

On June 5, 2026, a Prehearing Conference Notice was issued which established a telephonic prehearing conference for this matter on Friday, June 12, 2026, at 10:00 a.m. In addition, a Prehearing Conference Order, which set forth rules that would govern the prehearing conference, was also issued.

On June 9, 2026, the OSBA filed a Formal Complaint and Public Statement.

On June 10, 2026, UGI, OCA, OSBA and I&E filed their respective prehearing memorandums.

On June 12, 2026, a prehearing conference was held in which UGI, OCA, OSBA, and I&E were represented.

On June 22, 2026, the Commission issued our Prehearing Order, which, amongst other things, adopted the litigation schedule and Commission discovery modifications agreed upon by the parties at the June 12, 2026, prehearing conference.

On June 23, 2026, a Hearing Notice was issued scheduling an evidentiary hearing in this matter for Wednesday, July 29, 2026.

On June 30, 2026, UGI filed a Motion for Protective Order which was granted by Order dated July 1, 2026.

On July 17, 2026, by email, the parties informed us that they have reached a settlement in principle that fully resolves all issues in this proceeding. As a result, the parties requested that the procedural schedule in this matter be suspended, that the evidentiary hearing be cancelled, and that the parties be directed to file a Joint Stipulation for Admission of Evidence. Additionally, the parties requested to file the Joint Petition for Settlement of All Issues, including Statements in Support, by the Reply Brief date of August 21, 2026.

On July 20, 2026, a Hearing Cancellation Notice was issued cancelling the evidentiary hearing scheduled for Wednesday, July 29, 2026.

The Ordering paragraphs below formally grant the requests made by the parties through their July 17, 2026 email.

ORDER

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the July 29, 2026, evidentiary hearing scheduled in this matter is cancelled.
2. That a fully executed Joint Petition for Settlement of All Issues, accompanied by substantive Statements in Support submitted by all signatories, shall be filed on or before 4:30 p.m., August 21, 2026.
3. That a Joint Stipulation for Admission of Evidence accompanied by verifications of the witnesses who provided the testimony and exhibits shall be filed on or before 4:30 p.m., August 21, 2026.
