RE: UGI Utilities' Universal Service and Energy Conservation Plan for 2026-2030

Overview

On June 4, 2026, the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission entered an Order at the captioned dockets approving the 2026 USECP conditioned upon UGI incorporating the changes directed in the Order. The Commission directed UGI Utilities Inc. to submit a revised 2026-2030 Universal Service and Energy Conservation Plan (2026 USECP) within 30 days reflecting changes consistent with the June 2026 Order. June 2026 Order at 169, OP#3.

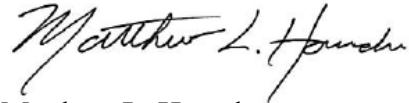
On July 2, 2026, UGI filed clean and redlined versions of its revised 2026 USECP (July 2 Compliance Filing). The Commission's Bureau of Consumer Services (BCS) has reviewed the July 2 Compliance Filing and finds it consistent with the June 2026 Order. To date, no protests or other responsive pleadings have been filed relative to the July 2 Compliance Filing.

Conclusion

Accordingly, BCS finds the July 2 Compliance Filing to be compliant with the June 2026 Order. Parties have the right to seek reconsideration of this staff action. These staff determinations relative to the review of UGI's 2026 USECP will be deemed to be the final action of the Commission unless reconsideration is sought from the Commission within 20 days after service of this Secretarial Letter. See 52 Pa. Code § 5.44 (relating to petitions for appeal from actions of the staff).
