STATUS REPORT

TO THE PENNSYLVANIA PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION:

PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (“PPL Electric” or the “Company”) submits the following status report to Administrative Law Judges Emily A. Farren and Steven K. Haas (the “ALJs”), which provides details for the proposed site visits in the above-captioned proceedings.

I. INTRODUCTION

On July 10, 2026, the active parties in the above-captioned proceedings participated in a Prehearing Conference presided over by the ALJs. At the Prehearing Conference, the ALJs required PPL Electric to confer with the parties and provide a status report containing details for requested site visits by July 20, 2026, including dates, times, and location, rain dates, estimated length of visits, parking, designated meeting spots, access to drinking water and protection from the elements, security measures, and accommodations. The ALJs also directed the parties to submit memoranda addressing whether site visits should be conducted along alternative routes. On July 17, 2026, Counsel representing certain of the landowners filed a joint proposed site visit schedule for October 13, 14, and 15, 2026. On July 20, 2026, PPL Electric provided an initial status report stating that it was still reviewing the proposed schedule and that the Company would provide an additional status report by July 27, 2026. The parties submitted memoranda addressing whether site visits should be conducted along alternative routes on July 17, 22, and 24, 2026.

II. STATUS REPORT

Prior to filing this status report, PPL Electric discussed the site visit details requested by the ALJs with the active parties. PPL Electric can represent that no party objects to the proposed site visit details. It is PPL Electric’s understanding that no party objected to the site visit schedule circulated on July 17. Because the issue of whether to hold alternative route site visits is pending,

PPL Electric marks the agenda for the afternoon of October 14 as “to be determined” but otherwise reproduces that schedule below.

A. Proposed Site Visit Details

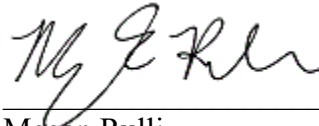
