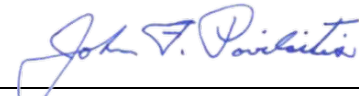

**MOTION OF TRANSOURCE PENNSYLVANIA, LLC. FOR RELIEF IN THE NATURE
OF AN ORDER DIRECTING PUBLICATION OF NOTICE OF THE FILING OF A
MOTION TO CONSOLIDATE PROCEEDINGS**

TO ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGES STEVEN K. HAAS AND EMILY A. FARREN:

Transource Pennsylvania, LLC (“Transource PA” or the “Company”), by and through its attorneys, hereby files this Motion, pursuant to the regulations of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission” or “PaPUC”) at 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.51(a), 5.81 and 5.103, and in connection therewith, represents as follows:

I. INTRODUCTION

1. Through this Motion, Transource PA is requesting that the presiding Administrative Law Judges (“ALJs”) direct Transource PA to publish notice in general circulation newspapers of its prior filing of a Motion to Consolidate the above-captioned proceedings as described further below. Transource PA has no objection to the ALJs also directing publication of Notice of the filing of the Motion to Consolidate in the Pennsylvania Bulletin if deemed appropriate. Such a ruling would inform potentially impacted parties of the proposed consolidation of the above-captioned proceedings, thereby protecting their rights to procedural due process. Directing such publication would have no adverse impact on any existing or future party to these proceedings since Transource PA will pay for all costs associated with publishing notice as requested herein.

II. BACKGROUND

2. On May 21, 2026, Transource PA filed, pursuant to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code (“Code”), at 66 Pa.C.S. § 1101 *et seq.*, an application requesting all necessary authority, approvals, and certificates of public convenience (“CPC”) from the Commission necessary to authorize Transource PA to begin to furnish and supply electric transmission service as a Pennsylvania public utility within portions of Franklin County, Pennsylvania (“CPC Application”).

3. The CPC Application was filed in connection with the “9A West Project”, which involves the siting and construction of the new Rice-Ringgold 230 kV Transmission Line that will extend approximately 28.8 miles to connect the existing Ringgold Substation located near Smithsburg, Washington County, Maryland and the new Rice Substation to be located in Franklin

County, Pennsylvania. Approximately 24.4 miles of the 9A West Project will be located in Pennsylvania and approximately 4.4 miles will be located in Maryland.

4. The 9A West Project was borne out of PJM Interconnection LLC's¹ ("PJM") planning process known as the Regional Transmission Expansion Plan and Market Efficiency Analysis, which previously selected and identified the original transmission project known as "Project 9A."

5. On July 30, 2025, the PJM Board of Managers found that the 9A West Project is still needed to establish market efficiency and reduce regional congestion costs and supports the prompt construction of needed infrastructure in the region.

6. Contemporaneously with the CPC Application, Transource PA filed, in accordance with 52 Pa. Code § 57.72, an application requesting Commission approval of the siting and construction of a proposed new electric substation and double-circuit Rice-Ringgold 230 kilovolt ("kV") electric transmission line and related facilities in a portion of Franklin County, Pennsylvania which, as noted above is referred to as the 9A West Project (the "Siting Application").

7. As noted above and in the Siting Application, the 9A West Project is needed to, among other things, enhance market efficiency and relieve regional congestion and related costs within the PJM area.

8. Contemporaneously with the CPC Application and the Siting Application, Transource PA filed, in accordance with 52 Pa. Code § Section 5.41 and Article VI of the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code (as reenacted and amended December 21, 1988, P.L. 1329, 53 P.S. §§ 10601-10619.1) ("MPC"), a Petition for Confirmation of an Exemption from

Local Zoning Regulation and for the Construction of Buildings in connection with the construction of a proposed electric substation in Greene Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania (“Zoning Petition”).

9. And contemporaneously with the CPC Application, Siting Application and Zoning Petition, Transource PA filed with the PUC a Motion to Consolidate Proceedings and For Timely Disposition (“Consolidation Motion”).

10. The PUC issued a Telephonic Prehearing Conference Notice on June 3, 2026 that advised that a Telephonic Prehearing Conference would be held on Wednesday, August 19, 2026 at 10:00 AM in connection with the CPC Application, Siting Application and the Zoning Petition.

11. Notice of the CPC Application, Siting Application and the Zoning Petition proceeding was published in the June 13, 2026 issue of the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*. That Notice indicated that a Telephonic Prehearing Conference would be held on Wednesday, August 19, 2026 at 10:00 AM and that formal protests and petitions to intervene in accordance with 52 Pa. Code (relating to public utilities) be filed on or before August 12, 2026.

12. On June 25, 2026, Office of Consumer Advocate (“OCA”) filed (i) an Answer Opposing the Consolidation Motion, (ii) a Protest to the CPC Application, (iii) a Protest to the Siting Application, and (iv) an Answer to the Zoning Exemption Petition.

13. On June 26, 2026, the OCA filed (i) an Amended Protest to the Sitting Application, and (ii) a letter requesting that the OCA’s original Protest be removed from the on-line PUC docket.

14. On July 2, 2026, Transource PA filed a letter at the CPC Application docket indicating that while it was not filing an Answer to the OCA’s Protest, such failure to file an Answer should not be construed as concurrence in the grounds alleged in the OCA Protest.

15. On July 2, 2026, Transource PA filed a letter with the PUC in connection with the CPC Application, Siting Application and Zoning Petition Dockets indicating its intention to file and serve a timely Reply to the OCA's Answer to the Consolidation Motion. *That letter also requested that the PUC publish notice of the Consolidation Motion in newspapers of general circulation and the Pennsylvania Bulletin. Transource PA also made this request in its July 15, 2026 Reply to New Matter of Office of Consumer Advocate.*

16. On July 2, 2026, Transource PA filed a letter with the PUC enclosing Affidavits of Publication of the Notice required by the PUC to be published in general circulation newspapers.

17. Numerous individuals and organizations have filed Protests and/or Petitions to Intervene to date in all three of the above-captioned proceedings. Attached to this Motion as Appendix A is a list of such individuals and organizations, each of which will be served with a copy of this Motion and Notice to Plead.

18. In an email to the presiding ALJs on July 22, 2026, counsel for Transource PA requested authorization from the ALJs to publish notice of the Consolidation Motion.

19. Given the impending close of the Protest Period, the August 19, 2026 prehearing conference and Transource PA's desire to ensure that all potentially impacted stakeholders have received notice of the request contained in the Consolidation Motion, Transource PA is renewing its request for publication formally through this Motion.

III. Legal Standards

20. The Commission's Rules of Administrative Practice and Procedure permit parties to file preliminary motions. 52 Pa. Code §§ 5.101-103.

21. Motion practice before the Commission is governed by Section 103 of its regulations, 52 Pa. Code §§ 5.103:

§ 5.103. Motions.

(a) *Scope and content.* A request may be made by motion for relief desired, except as may be otherwise expressly provided in this chapter and Chapters 1 and 3 (relating to rules of administrative practice and procedure; and special provisions). A motion must set forth the ruling or relief sought, and state the grounds therefor and the statutory or other authority upon which it relies.

(b) *Presentation of motions.* A motion may be made in writing at any time, and a motion made during a hearing may be stated orally upon the record, or the presiding officer may require that an oral motion be reduced to writing and filed separately. Written motions must contain a notice which states that a responsive pleading shall be filed within 20 days of the date of service of the motion.

(c) *Response to motions.* A party has 20 days from the date of service within which to answer or object to a motion, unless the period of time is otherwise fixed by the Commission or the presiding officer.

(d) *Rulings on motions.*

(1) The presiding officer is authorized to rule and will rule upon motions:

(i) Not formerly acted upon by the Commission prior to the commencement of the hearing where an immediate ruling is essential in order to proceed with the hearing.

(ii) Filed or made after the commencement of the hearing and prior to the submission of a decision in the proceeding.

(2) A motion made during the course of hearing, which if granted would otherwise dispose of parties' rights, should be acted upon by the presiding officer prior to taking further testimony if, in the opinion of the presiding officer, the action is warranted.

(3) If a motion involves a question of jurisdiction, the establishment of a prima facie case or standing, the presiding officer may render a final determination with regard to a motion prior to the termination of hearings by issuing an initial or recommended decision.

(e) *Supersession.* Subsection (a) is identical to 1 Pa. Code § 35.177 (relating to scope and contents of motions). Subsection (b) is identical to 1 Pa. Code § 35.178 (relating to presentation of motions). Subsection (c) supersedes 1 Pa. Code § 35.179 (relating to objections to motions). Subsection (d) supersedes 1 Pa. Code § 35.180 (relating to action on motions).

22. Under 52 Pa. Code §§ 5.103, motions, among other things, (i) can be made at any time, (ii) may be offered in written form or orally, and (iii) must set forth the ruling or relief

sought and state the grounds therefore and the statutory or other authority upon which it relies. This Motion fully complies with these requirements.

IV. ARGUMENT

A. There is An Immediate Need to Publish Notice of the Consolidation Motion and the ALJs have the Authority to Direct Such Action.

23. The timely conduct and administration of all litigation before the Commission in connection with the CPC Application, Siting Application and the Zoning Petition are critical to all parties and stakeholders involved in these proceedings.

24. Indeed, Transource PA filed the Consolidation Motion with the Commission and the ALJs specifically to place before the ALJs the need to establish a litigation schedule and protocol that recognizes the interrelationship among the CPC Application, Siting Application and the Zoning Petition, while balancing the due process rights of all parties, including Transource PA's PJM mandated and contractually established deadline for completion of the 9A West Project in early 2029.

25. Transource PA believes that all potentially impacted parties have a right to procedural due process which includes, among other things, the right to have timely notice of the request to consolidate the proceedings associated with CPC Application, Siting Application and the Zoning Petition. Indeed, a number of the Protests and Petitions to Intervene filed to date in these proceedings have requested a course of action that is inconsistent with the relief requested in the Consolidation Motion. This divergence of views adds further support for the need to provide timely notice to all potentially impacted parties of the filing of the Consolidation Motion.

26. Since the Protest Period in these proceedings has not yet closed and the identity of potential future parties is not presently known, publication of notice of the filing of and relief

requested in the Consolidation Motion is the most effective means of protecting the due process rights of all actual and potential parties.

27. The Commission's regulations afford the ALJ's wide latitude in the conduct of proceedings before them, including directing notice by publication as requested in this Motion:

- "The Commission or presiding officer, with or without motion, may order proceedings involving a common question of law or fact to be consolidated. *The Commission or presiding officer may make orders concerning the conduct of the proceeding as may avoid unnecessary costs or delay.*" 52 Pa. Code § 5.81(a). (emphasis added).
- "The presiding officer will have the authority specified in the act, subject to this title. *This authority includes, but is not limited to,* the power to exclude irrelevant, immaterial or unduly repetitive evidence, to prevent excessive examination of witnesses, to schedule and impose reasonable limitations on discovery and *to otherwise regulate the course of the proceeding.* 52 Pa. Code § 5.483(a). (emphasis added).
- "Upon receiving an application, the Secretary will instruct the applicant or petitioner concerning the required service and public notice consistent with this section." 52 Pa. Code § 1.51(a).

28. While not directly applicable to motions, 52 Pa. Code § 5.14(b)(1) expressly allows the PUC to direct "[p]ublication in a newspaper of general circulation serving the geographical territory affected by the application."

B. Transource PA Requests the Shortening of the Otherwise Applicable Time for Responding to this Motion

29. Under 52 Pa. Code § 5.103(c), a party typically has 20 days from the date of service to respond to a Motion.

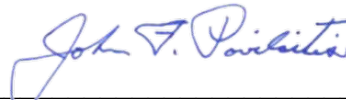
30. Given urgent need to advise all potential parties of the filing of the Consolidation Motion, Transource PA believes that shortening the normal answer period under 52 Pa. Code § 5.103(c) to ten (10) is both reasonable and necessary.

31. Further, Transource PA does not believe that the request to publish notice of the Consolidation Motion as requested herein is controversial or will have any adverse effect on

existing or future parties since publication is specifically intended to protect and not harm their procedural due process rights.

WHEREFORE, Transource Pennsylvania, LLC respectfully requests that the Administrative Law Judges (i) grant the relief requested in this Motion in its entirety including, (i) directing the immediate publication of the filing of the Consolidation Motion in newspapers of general circulation in the area of the proposed 9A West Project, and (ii) requesting that the Secretary of the Commission arrange for publication of Notice of the Consolidation Motion in the Pennsylvania Bulletin if deemed appropriate, and (iii) shortening the otherwise applicable period for filing a response to this Motion to ten (10) days from the date of service of this Motion and (ii) grant Transource Pennsylvania, LLC such other relief as may be just and reasonable under the circumstances.

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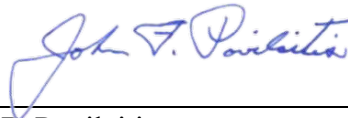

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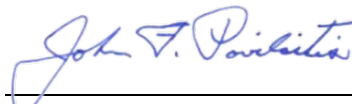

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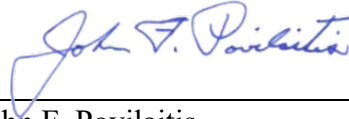
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
