INTERIM ORDER #1

This interim order (1) directs Transource Pennsylvania, LLC to republish the Notice of the Application of Transource Pennsylvania, LLC for All of the Necessary Authority, Approvals and Certificate of Public Convenience to Begin to Offer, Render, Furnish and/or Supply Transmission Service in Portions of Franklin County, Pennsylvania, Necessary to Operate Transmission Facilities for Project 9A West, at Docket No. A-2026-3062675, in newspapers of general circulation in Greene, Guildford, Quincy Townships and Waynesboro Borough, Franklin County, Pennsylvania; (2) directs Transource Pennsylvania, LLC to file proof of publication of said republished Notice with the Secretary's Bureau; (3) directs Transource Pennsylvania, LLC to update its service list to acknowledge all parties who have filed Protests, Interventions, or Notice of Appearances and the method of service preference of each party with respect to acceptance of e-Service or electronic mail to ensure timely receipt of documents filed by Transource Pennsylvania, LLC, as these first three directives are more fully set forth herein; (4) strikes: the July 2, 2026 Letter Request of Transource Pennsylvania, LLC; and the Reply of Transource Pennsylvania, LLC to New Matter of the Office of Consumer Advocate, filed on July 15, 2026, both as improper and deficient filings; (5) cancels and reschedules the prehearing conference previously scheduled to be held on August 19, 2026, to **Thursday, October 29, 2026, beginning at 9:00 AM**; and (6) extends the Protest and Intervention filing date from August 12, 2026, to **Thursday, October 15, 2026**.

HISTORY OF THE PROCEEDING

On May 21, 2026, Transource Pennsylvania, LLC (Transource PA) filed an Application with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, for All of the Necessary Authority, Approvals and Certificate of Public Convenience to Begin to Offer, Render, Furnish and/or Supply Transmission Service in Portions of Franklin County, Pennsylvania Necessary to Operate Transmission Facilities for Project 9A West, pursuant to Section 1101 of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa.C.S. § 1101, to commence the provision of transmission electric service as a public utility in portions of Franklin County, Pennsylvania (CPC Application). Upon receipt of the CPC Application, the Secretary's Bureau docketed the CPC Application at Docket No. A-2026-3062675.

On May 21, 2026, Transource PA filed a separate Application seeking the Commission's approval for the siting and construction of a proposed new electric substation and double-circuit Rice-Ringgold 230 kV electric transmission line and related facilities in portions of Franklin County, Pennsylvania (Siting Application), along with a Petition for Confirmation of an Exemption from Local Zoning Regulation and for the Construction of Buildings (Zoning Exemption Petition). Upon receipt of the Siting Application and Zoning Exemption Petition, the Secretary's Bureau docketed the filings at A-2026-3062686 and P-2026-3062687, respectively.

Lastly on May 21, 2026, Transource PA filed the Motion of Transource Pennsylvania, LLC to Consolidate Proceedings and for Timely Disposition, requesting that the CPC Application, Siting Application and the Zoning Exemption Petition be formally consolidated into a single proceeding for all purposes including hearings, briefing and a final decision by the Commission to be entered no later than February 22, 2027.

On June 3, 2026, the Commission issued two separate prehearing conference notices (June 3 Prehearing Conference Notices), one for the CPC Application, at Docket No. A-2026-3062675; and one for the Siting Application and Zoning Exemption Petition, at Docket Nos. A-2026-3062686, P-2026-3062687, respectively.

The purpose of the Prehearing Conference Notices was to alert interested parties that a prehearing conference would be held on August 19, 2026, at 10:00 AM.

The Prehearing Conference Notices also indicated that the CPC Application, Siting Application and Zoning Exemption Petition proceedings were not formally consolidated, and the issues related to, and the potential for consolidation, would be discussed at the prehearing conference.

The Prehearing Conference Notices were also published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* on June 13, 2026. 56 Pa.B. 3592 (Siting Application and Zoning Exemption Petition); 56 Pa.B. 3593 (CPC Application).

On June 25, 2026, the Office of Consumer Advocate (OCA) filed an Answer to Motion to Consolidate Proceedings and for Timely Disposition (herein after OCA's Answer in Opposition), opposing Transource PA's request to consolidate the CPC Application, Siting Application and Zoning Exemption Petition.

On June 25, 2026, OCA also filed a Protest to the Siting Application and an Answer to the Zoning Exemption Petition.

On July 2, 2026, Transource PA filed a letter (*July 2, 2026 Letter Request*) in response to the OCA's Answer in Opposition to inform the Commission that Transource PA: (1) intended to file and serve a timely reply to the OCA's Answer in Opposition; and, (2) requested that the Commission publish Notice of the Motion to Consolidate Proceedings and for Timely Disposition in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* as soon as possible and direct Transource PA to publish such Notice in newspapers of general circulation.

Also on July 2, 2026, Transource PA filed Affidavits of Publication (Affidavits) of the Notice of the Application of Transource Pennsylvania, LLC filed Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code Chapter 57, Subchapter G, for Approval of the Siting and Construction of the 230 kV Transmission Line Known as Project 9A West in a Portion of Franklin County, Pennsylvania, at

Docket No. A-2026-3062686, along with Notice of the Petition of Transource Pennsylvania, LLC for Confirmation of an Exemption from Local Zoning Regulation and for the Construction of Buildings in Connection with the Construction of a Proposed Electric Substation in Greene Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, at Docket No. P-2026-3062687.

On July 15, 2026, Transource PA filed a document titled the Reply of Transource Pennsylvania, LLC to New Matter of Office of Consumer Advocate. The cover letter to the filing included a reiteration of the *July 2, 2026 Letter Request*.

On July 22, 2026, counsel for Transource PA emailed the undersigned Administrative Law Judges a reiteration of the *July 2, 2026 Letter Request*.

Notice of the Siting Application, the *July 2, 2026 Letter Request*, and the Reply of Transource Pennsylvania, LLC to New Matter of Office of Consumer Advocate are now ripe for discussion and disposition.

DISCUSSION

Commission regulations and applicable statutory provisions are intended to ensure that parties and the public receive adequate notice of the claims asserted and the relief requested, while safeguarding due process. As the Commonwealth Court explained, “[c]onsiderations of due process involve common-sense reasoning and fundamental fairness. Due process is a flexible concept incapable of exact definition, and is concerned with the procedural safeguards demanded by each particular situation in light of the legitimate goals of the applicable law.” *Commonwealth v. 2338 N. Beechwood St. Phila.*, 134 A.3d 507 (Pa. Cmwlth. 2016).

Transource PA’s filings and OCA’s response

Motion of Transource Pennsylvania, LLC to Consolidate Proceedings and for Timely Disposition

Section 5.1 of the Commission regulations, “pleadings allowed,” provides, in pertinent part, as follows:

(a) The pleadings in an action before the Commission include the following:

- (1) Application and protest.
- (2) Formal complaint, answer, new matter and reply to new matter.
- (3) Order to show cause and answer.
- (4) Petition and answer.
- (5) Preliminary objections.
- (6) Motions.

52 Pa. Code § 5.1 (a).

Here, on May 21, 2026, Transource PA filed the Motion of Transource Pennsylvania, LLC to Consolidate Proceedings and for Timely Disposition, requesting that the CPC Application, Siting Application and the Zoning Petition be formally consolidated into a single proceeding for all purposes including hearings, briefing and a final decision by the Commission to be entered no later than February 22, 2027.

The filing captioned “Motion to Consolidate Proceedings and for Timely Disposition” met, in part, the requirements of Section 5.103, 52 Pa. Code § 5.103, inasmuch as it requested that the CPC Application, Siting Application and the Zoning Petition be formally consolidated into a single proceeding for all purposes including hearings, briefing and a final decision by the Commission, and provided legal authority in support of the requested relief as to consolidation. *See* Motion of Transource Pennsylvania, LLC to Consolidate Proceedings and for Timely Disposition at ¶ 10 & n.2, ¶ 11 & n.3, ¶ 13.

As for the requested relief “for timely disposition,” to the extent that Transource PA intended this portion of the document title, together with Paragraph 14 of the filing, to amount to a petition for the Commission to grant expedited consideration of the Siting Application, pursuant to Section 57.75(g) of Commission regulations, 52 Pa. Code § 57.75(g), the request is denied, without prejudice, for Transource PA’s failure to comply with applicable Commission regulations.

No notice to plead accompanied the Motion of Transource Pennsylvania, LLC to Consolidate Proceedings and for Timely Disposition filing.

Disposition

Consideration of and ruling on the Motion of Transource Pennsylvania, LLC to Consolidate Proceedings and for Timely Disposition will be held in abeyance until after all interested parties are given the opportunity to respond, either by answering or objecting to, the Motion, including any arguments presented at the Prehearing Conference.

OCA’s Answer Opposing Transource PA’s Motion to Consolidate and for Timely Disposition

Here, Transource PA filed the Motion of Transource Pennsylvania, LLC to Consolidate Proceedings and for Timely Disposition, and, upon the filing of the Motion, a party, here the OCA, had the right to answer or object to the Motion. 52 Pa. Code § 5.103(c).

The OCA filed its response: Answer Opposing Transource PA’s Motion to Consolidate and for Timely Disposition (Answer in Opposition) on June 25, 2026, in accordance with Sections 5.61 and 5.103 of Commission regulations. 52 Pa. Code §§ 5.61, 5.103.

In its Answer in Opposition, the OCA cited, in part, an Opinion and Order of the Commission entered June 1, 2026, in another matter pending before the Commission to support its argument opposing consolidation of the CPC Application, and the Siting Application and

Zoning Petition.¹ In so doing, the OCA provided legal argument and intervening authority in response to Transource PA's Motion. This is appropriate advocacy.

Disposition

Stated differently, the OCA's Answer in Opposition did not constitute new matter. Citing intervening authority did not create a procedural right for Transource PA, or any other party, to file an additional reply without leave.

The July 2, 2026 Letter Request

Here, Transource PA filed a letter on July 2, 2026, (*July 2, 2026 Letter Request*) in response to the OCA's Answer in Opposition.

The *July 2, 2026 Letter Request* "informs" the presiding Administrative Law Judges (ALJs) that Transource PA intended to file and serve a timely reply to the OCA Answer.

No legal authority was cited to support Transource PA's asserted procedural right to file a reply to OCA's Answer in Opposition.

The *July 2, 2026 Letter Request* also requested that the Commission publish notice of the Motion of Transource Pennsylvania, LLC to Consolidate Proceedings and for Timely Disposition, in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* and direct Transource PA to publish the notice in newspapers of general circulation.

No legal authority was cited to support the request for the Commission to cause or direct publication of the Motion.

No notice to plead accompanied the *July 2, 2026 Letter Request*.

The culmination of these failures stripped actual and potential parties of their rights under Section 5.103(c), 52 Pa. Code § 5.103(c), to answer or object to Transource PA's: (1) assertion of its procedural right to file a reply to OCA's Answer in Opposition as a matter of course; or (2) request that its Motion to Consolidate and for Timely Disposition be published. In the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*.

Disposition

In sum, the *July 2, 2026 Letter Request* failed to conform to Commission rules and regulations yet sought to expand the litigant's own procedural rights. To cure these procedural missteps, it is appropriate to strike the *July 2, 2026 Letter* from the record.

Reply of Transource Pennsylvania, LLC to New Matter of Office of Consumer Advocate

Here, Transource PA filed a Motion. Then, the OCA filed its Answer in Opposition to the Motion. Then, Transource PA filed a document entitled Reply of Transource Pennsylvania, LLC to New Matter of Office of Consumer Advocate.

Once more, pleadings allowed in an action before the Commission are limited to, in relevant part here: motions and responses to motions. 52 Pa. Code §§ 5.1(a)(6), 5.103(c).

Litigants cannot confer procedural rights upon themselves. Commission rules and regulations do not contemplate the procedural process Transource PA attempted here: motion, followed by a response to the motion, followed by a response to the response.

Where the Commission's rules do not authorize an additional filing, the proper course is to file a motion for leave, not file first and presume the authority to do so.

As discussed herein, the OCA's Answer in Opposition did not amount to new matter. Labeling OCA's responsive pleading new matter in an effort to generate authority to file a response, dressed as a reply to new matter, exceeded the procedural process contemplated.

Disposition

To cure this procedural misstep, it is appropriate to strike from the record, the Reply of Transource Pennsylvania, LLC to New Matter of Office of Consumer Advocate, filed on July 15, 2026.

Conclusion

To allow time for all interested parties to receive and act upon notice of (1) the CPC Application; and, (2) the rescheduled Prehearing Conference, the following order will be entered.

ORDER

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That Transource Pennsylvania, LLC is directed to publish Notice of the Application of Transource Pennsylvania, LLC for All of the Necessary Authority, Approvals and Certificate of Public Convenience to Begin to Offer, Render, Furnish and/or Supply Transmission Service in Portions of Franklin County, Pennsylvania, Necessary to Operate Transmission Facilities for Project 9A West, at Docket No. A-2026-3062675, precisely as the In-Person Prehearing Conference Notice, as attached to this Order appears

(2) That Transource Pennsylvania, LLC is directed to update its service list to acknowledge parties who have filed Interventions, Protests or Notice of Appearances, along with the parties' preferred method of service to ensure other parties' timely receipt of documents filed by Transource Pennsylvania, LLC.

(3) That the July 2, 2026 Letter filed by Transource Pennsylvania, LLC at Docket Nos. A-2026-3062675, A-2026-3062686, and P-2026-3062687, is hereby stricken from the record.

(4) That the Reply of Transource Pennsylvania, LLC to New Matter of Office of Consumer Advocate, filed by Transource Pennsylvania, LLC on July 15, 2026, at Docket Nos. A-2026-3062675, A-2026-3062686, and P-2026-3062687, is hereby stricken from the record.

(5) That all parties are directed to comply with Commission Rules and Regulations for future filings, noting that correspondence via electronic mail, letter requests and the like, are not a substitute for proper pleadings.

(6) That the Motion of Transource Pennsylvania, LLC to Consolidate Proceedings and for Timely Disposition will be ruled upon by separate order, following the Prehearing Conference, rescheduled for **October 29, 2026, at 9:00 AM**.

(7) That the Formal Protest and Petition to Intervene filing deadline to the Application of Transource Pennsylvania, LLC, for All of the Necessary Authority, Approvals and Certificate of Public Convenience to Begin to Offer, Render, Furnish and/or Supply Transmission Service in Portions of Franklin County, Pennsylvania, Necessary to Operate Transmission Facilities for Project 9A West, at Docket No. A-2026-3062675, is hereby extended to **October 15, 2026**.

(8) That any Formal Protest or Petition to Intervene previously filed need not be refiled.

(9) That the Secretary's Bureau publish Notice of the Application of Transource Pennsylvania, LLC for All of the Necessary Authority, Approvals and Certificate of Public Convenience to Begin to Offer, Render, Furnish and/or Supply Transmission Service in Portions of Franklin County, Pennsylvania, Necessary to Operate Transmission Facilities for Project 9A West, at Docket No. A-2026-3062675, with a Protest or Intervention deadline of October 15, 2026, along with Notice of the In-Person Prehearing Conference, scheduled for **October 29, 2026**, to begin at 9:00 AM, in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* on August 15, 2026.

(10) That the Notice to be Published in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin* includes a formal protest and petition to intervene deadline of October 15, 2026.

PURPOSE. The purpose of the Prehearing Conference is to discuss all relevant procedural issues, including *inter alia*, consolidation, development of a procedural schedule, and deadlines for discovery, related to these three proceedings. The parties shall be fully prepared for a useful discussion of all issues involved in the proceedings, both procedural and substantive, and fully authorized to make commitments with respect thereto. *See* 52 Pa. Code § 5.222(d).

PREHEARING CONFERENCE MEMORANDA. Parties will be required to file Prehearing Conference Memoranda on or before October 22, 2026. Further instructions will be provided.

CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE APPLICATION. On May 21, 2026, Transource Pennsylvania, LLC filed an Application requesting the Commission grant and issue Transource Pennsylvania, LLC the necessary certificate(s) of public convenience under the Public Utility Code to begin to furnish and supply electric transmission service to or for the public within portions of Franklin County, Pennsylvania as a transmission-only public utility.

SITING AND CONSTRUCTION APPLICATION AND ZONING EXEMPTION PETITION.

On May 21, 2026, Transource Pennsylvania, LLC filed an Application seeking the Commission's approval for the siting and construction of a proposed new electric substation and double-circuit Rice-Ringgold 230 kV electric transmission line and related facilities in portions of Franklin County, Pennsylvania, referred to as the 9A West Project. The 9A West Project proposes the siting and construction of a new Rice-Ringgold 230 kV transmission line that would extend approximately 28.8 miles to connect the existing Ringgold Substation located near Smithsburg, Washington County, Maryland and the proposed Rice Substation to be located in Franklin County, Pennsylvania. Approximately 24.4 miles of the proposed 28.8-mile 9A West Project would be located in Pennsylvania and approximately 4.4 miles would be located in Maryland and a Petition for Confirmation of an Exemption from Local Zoning Regulation and for the Construction of Buildings in connection with the construction of a proposed electric substation in Franklin County, Pennsylvania requesting the Commission exempt Transource Pennsylvania, LLC from all local zoning, land development and any other land use regulation under Pennsylvania law, specifically exemption from local zoning, land development, and any other local land use regulations for any control buildings/modules proposed to be constructed at the Rice Substation in Greene Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania.

NOTES. Due to the anticipated overlapping of issues and parties, the Prehearing Conference is being scheduled in the Siting and Construction Application and Zoning Exemption Petition matters, contemporaneously with the Application of Transource Pennsylvania, LLC for All of the Necessary Authority, Approvals and Certificate of Public Convenience to Begin to Offer, Render, Furnish and/or Supply Transmission Service in Portions of Franklin County, Pennsylvania Necessary to Operate Transmission Facilities for Project 9A West, at Docket No. A-2026-3062675 (Certificate of Public Convenience Application, discussed above). However, these proceedings have not been formally consolidated.
