INTERIM ORDER
DIRECTING SUBMISSION OF A STATUS REPORT WITH A
MODIFIED LITIGATION SCHEDULE

A Prehearing Conference was held on April 14, 2026 with Veolia Water Pennsylvania, Inc. (“Veolia”), the Office of Small Business Advocate (“OSBA”) and the Office of Consumer Advocate (“OCA”) in attendance. At the Prehearing Conference, Veolia, OSBA and OCA (collectively referred to as “the Parties”) agreed to the following litigation schedule:

Public Input Hearings	July 28-29, 2026
Direct Testimony from OSBA and OCA	August 31, 2026
Direct Testimony from Veolia	September 25, 2026
Rebuttal Testimony from OSBA and OCA\	October 19, 2026
Surrebuttal Testimony from Veolia	November 2, 2026
Written Outline of Oral Rejoinder	November 9, 2026
In-Person Hearing	December 2-3, 2026
Main Briefs	December 23, 2026
Reply Briefs	January 14, 2027

On May 14, 2026, a Prehearing Order was issued adopting the above litigation schedule and indicating that the in-person hearing would be scheduled at a hearing room to be determined in the Keystone Building located at 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120.

It has recently been brought to my attention that there are no hearing rooms available at the Keystone Building on December 2, 2026 due to renovations occurring at the building. Therefore, the in-person hearing day scheduled for December 2, 2026 will need to be rescheduled.

Accordingly, I ask the Parties to confer and submit an agreed upon modified litigation schedule that will accommodate rescheduling the December 2, 2026 hearing date. Currently, there are hearing rooms open on the following dates in December:

- December 3, 2026 – December 4, 2026
- December 7, 2026
- December 9, 2026 – December 11, 2026
- December 14, 2026 – December 18, 2026
- December 21, 2026 – December 23, 2026
- December 28, 2026 – December 30, 2026

Should the parties choose to move the hearing dates to January 2027 or later, there should be no issues with hearing room availability.

Accordingly, the Parties will be directed to confer with each other and file a status report on or before September 7, 2026 with a modified litigation schedule that will accommodate rescheduling the December 2, 2026 hearing date as well as availability of the Parties and their witnesses.

THEREFORE;

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Veolia Water Pennsylvania, Inc., the Office of Small Business Advocate and the Office of Consumer Advocate shall confer with each other and file a status report with an agreed upon modified litigation schedule in accordance with the above language on or before September 7, 2026.
