ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

Before the Commission is a letter from the Regenerative Energy Initiative (the REI) dated June 26, 2026, informing the Commission of the selection of two nominees to its Board of Directors. Commission approval of the proposed Board members is required under the PPL Electric Utilities Corporation restructuring settlement. *Application of Pennsylvania Power and Light Company for Approval of its Restructuring Plan under Section 2806 of the Public Utility Code, et al.*, Docket No. R-00973954 (Order entered August 27, 1998). Commission approval of the proposed Board members is also required by the REI's governing bylaws. *PP&L, Inc. Sustainable Energy Fund Bylaws*, Docket R-00973954 (Order entered June 2, 2000); *Request for Approval of Revisions to the Bylaws of the PPL*

Sustainable Energy Fund of Central Eastern Pennsylvania, Docket M-00031715F0003 (Orders entered April 1, 2011, January 28, 2016, and October 26, 2017); *Petition of the Sustainable Energy Fund for Approval of Revisions to the By-Laws that Govern its Operation*, Docket M-2023-3041567 (Order entered December 18, 2025).

The REI's Board of Directors voted on May 20, 2026, to approve the nominations of Judith Cassel and Garrett Powell to the REI's Board of Directors. The REI has two Board members, Evan Pappas and Lynn Rothman, that are term limited and have completed their terms. Ms. Cassel will replace Mr. Pappas, and Mr. Powell will replace Ms. Rothman.

Ms. Cassel is the Managing Partner for Hawke McKeon & Sniscak LLP in Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, with a focus in administrative and commercial law. Ms. Cassel has over 20 years of experience in highly regulated industries such as petroleum, natural gas, and electricity and has represented energy clients with matters before the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, Department of Environmental Protection, and the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission. Ms. Cassel holds a Bachelor of Arts from Penn State University, a Master of Business Administration from Lebanon Valley College, as well as a Juris Doctorate from Dickinson Law School.

Mr. Powell is the Sustainability Program Lead for Lutron Electronics, Inc. Mr. Powell is an advocate for sustainable and regenerative projects, launching Lutron's Global Sustainability Program in 2023 and integrating sustainability into existing processes across the organization and with suppliers. Mr. Powell has recently organized a Green House Gas Inventory at Lutron to help identify emission reduction opportunities. Mr. Powell, a resident of Harleysville,

Pennsylvania, holds a Bachelor of Science in Mechanical Engineering from Bucknell University.

The REI's Board of Directors and staff conducted a search process for qualified Board members and selected the respondents from this search. The REI's recruitment process was performed according to the *PA Sustainable Energy Board Best Practices for Nomination, Election and Approval of Directors*.

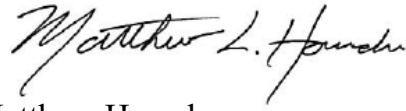
Based on a review of all relevant information, we find these nominees to be well-qualified to serve on the REI's Board of Directors. **THEREFORE,**
