Enclosed is a RATE CHANGE for the existing exception tariff, Tristate 54, Effective September 14th, 2026, for V I P Trucking, Inc. (PA PUC Certificate #A-00109327) in Lebanon PA.

This filing is a request for an **INCREASE** in local hourly rates (Monday-Friday and Saturdays & after regular hours on Weekdays), a **CHANGE** in the application of minimum transportation charges for local moves & travel time charges, the **ADDITION** of specific accessorial fee exceptions on shipments transported in excess of forty (40) miles and container & packing/unpacking per container charges.

The insurance information on the PA PUC website was checked and it appears that insurance forms E and H are in compliance.

The Issue Date for these changes in Tristate 54 is August 14th, 2026, with an Effective Date of September 14th, 2026.

NOTE 1 - Traveling charges (Column 1) are in addition to hourly rates (Columns 2, 3 and 4).

NOTE 2 - Hourly rates (Columns 2, 3 and 4) are based on the day or days as indicated, during which services are performed.

NOTE 3 - Hourly rates (Columns 2, 3, and 4) computed in half-hour periods; fractions of one-half hour considered as one-half hour.

▲ NOTE 4 - Minimum Transportation Charge: Sundays and Holidays (any hour): 4 hours plus applicable travel time charge at rates named in Columns 1 and 2. Saturdays (any hour) or Weekdays (6:01PM to 5:59AM): 4 hours plus applicable travel time charge at rates named in Columns 1 and 4. Weekdays (6:00AM to 6:00PM): 4 hours plus applicable travel time charge at rates named in Columns 1 and 3.

NOTE 5 - Carrier will supply and charge for supervisor or supervisors as requested by shipper. Hourly rate for each supervisor will be computed from time of arrival of vehicles and men at first point of origin until completion of unloading and dismissal of vehicles and men at final destination unless other time of arrival or dismissal is provided by agreement between shipper and carrier.

NOTE 6 - When a holiday falls on a Saturday, the rates named in Columns 1 and 2 shall be applicable.

NOTE 7 - When shipment is held overnight for the convenience of the shipper, an additional cost of **\$200.00** per truck per night will apply.

▲ NOTE AA - Travel charge to be based on the applicable transportation rates shown in Columns 2, 3, and 4 and will apply as follows based on the combined actual road miles from the carrier's terminal to the first point of origin and from the final destination back to the carrier's terminal using Mileage Guide No. 40 or a software program designed to calculate mileage, such as, Google Maps, MapQuest or TruckRouter.

0 - 30 miles	1/2 hour
31 - 50 miles	1 hour
51 - 70 miles	1 1/2 hours

For mileage in excess of 70 miles, a travel time charge of 1/2 hour will be assessed for each additional 20 miles.

NOTE 4 - OVERTIME LOADING/UNLOADING (Item 240) - Rates shown for **Dauphin County** will apply for all counties within Pennsylvania.

NOTE 5 - ELEVATORS, STAIR CARRY, EXCESSIVE DISTANCE (Item 260) - Rates shown under **Schedule C** will apply for all counties within Pennsylvania.
