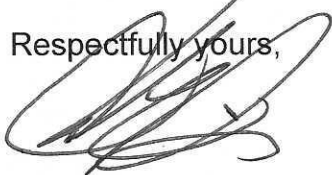
The PA PUC website was checked and Insurance Forms E & H appear to be current and in compliance.

SECTION 1
RULES & REGULATIONS

ITEM 10 - SCOPE OF CARRIER'S OPERATING AUTHORITY

Rates and provisions named in this tariff, or as amended, are limited in their application on Pennsylvania intrastate commerce to the extent of the operating rights set forth below.

Certificate No. A-8917548

To transport, as a common carrier, by motor vehicle, household goods in use throughout the
Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and between points within the Commonwealth.

ITEM 20 - GOVERNING OUBLICATIONS

For rates, rules, regulations and provisions applicable to the transportation of household goods, in use, except as otherwise specifically provided herein, see Tariff Freight Pa. P.U.C. No. 53 (Carrier Directory No. 53), loose-leaf revisions thereto and successive issues thereof, issued by Tristate Household Goods Tariff Conference, Inc., Agent.

ITEM 30 - DECLARED VALUE

Rates and charges named herein applicable when the value declared by shipper does not exceed sixty (60) cents per pound per article. For the method of determining rates when declared value exceeds sixty (60) cents per pound per article, see Governing Tariff.

Abbreviations, reference marks and symbols are explained on last page of tariff.

SECTION 2
SCHEDULE OF RATES

ITEM 200 - CLASSIFICATION OF PROPERTY

Applicable on the transportation of CLASS 1 SHIPMENTS (household goods in use) transported distances of forty (40) miles or less.

Class 1 shipments are personal effects and property used or to be used in a dwelling when a part of the equipment or supply of such dwelling and such other similar property: except that this subparagraph shall not be construed to include property moving from a factory or store, except such property as the householder has purchased with the intent to use in his/her dwelling and which is transported at the request of, and the transportation charges paid to the carrier by the householder.

Subject to Note AA and 1 to 5 below, the transportation charges on any shipment shall be a COMBINATION of the applicable TRAVEL CHARGE used in Column 1 plus HOURLY CHARGES at applicable rates name in Column 2.

Hourly rates apply only from the time of arrival of vehicles and men at first point of origin (continue during all loading, transportation from the first point of origin to the final destination, including any additional stops, and unloading) until completion of unloading and dismissal of vehicles and men by the shipper at the final destination.

NOTE 1 - Traveling charges (Column 1) are in addition to the hourly rates (Column 2).

NOTE 2 - Hourly rates (Column 2) computed in one (1) hour periods; fractions of one (1) hour considered as one (1) hour.

NOTE 3 - Schedule C rates in Tristate 50-T will be used for packing/unpacking labor anywhere in Pennsylvania for local moves.

NOTE 4 - Minimum total transportation charge to be based on two (2) hours plus applicable travel time charge using rates named in Column 2.

NOTE 5 - When for the convenience of the shipper, shipment is held in the moving van overnight, a charge of **\$150.00** per truck per night will be assessed in addition to all other applicable charges.

▲ NOTE AA - Travel charge to be based on the applicable transportation rates shown in Columns 2, 3, and 4 and will apply as follows based on the combined actual road miles from the carrier's terminal to the first point of origin and from the final destination back to the carrier's terminal using Mileage Guide No. 40 or a software program designed to calculate mileage, such as, Google Maps, MapQuest or TruckRouter.

0 - 15 miles	1/2 hour
16 - 30 miles	1 hour
31 - 45 miles	
46 - 60 miles	1 1/2 hours

For mileage in excess of 60 miles, a travel time charge of 1/2 hour will be assessed for each additional 20 miles.

▲ In lieu of the applicable rates provided for in Tariff Freight PA. P.U.C. No. 51-W for shipments transported in excess of forty (40) miles, the following rates shall apply:

NOTE 1 - PACKING & UNPACKING LABOR CHARGE (Item 110) - Rates shown under **Schedule C** will apply for all counties within Pennsylvania.

NOTE 2 - LABOR RATE (Item 120) - Labor Rates shown for **Fayette County** will apply for all counties within Pennsylvania.

NOTE 3 - ADDITIONAL TRANSPORTATION CHARGE (Item 160) - Rates shown under **Group 2** will apply for all counties within Pennsylvania.

NOTE 4 - EXTRA PICKUP AND/OR DELIVERY (Item 230) - Rates shown under **Schedule E** will apply for all counties within Pennsylvania.

NOTE 5 - OVERTIME LOADING/UNLOADING (Item 240) - Rates shown for **Fayette County** will apply for all counties within Pennsylvania.

NOTE 6 - ELEVATORS, STAIR CARRY, EXCESSIVE DISTANCE (Item 260) - Rates shown under **Schedule D** will apply for all counties within Pennsylvania.

SECTION 3
VALUATION

 FULL VALUE PROTECTION

When a shipment is moved with Full-Value Protection (FVP) coverage, a value must be declared by the Shipper on the Bill of Lading for the entire shipment. The Full-Value Protection rates shown below apply for distances of forty (40) miles or less and distances over forty (40) miles. The cost of the Full-Value Protection coverage shall be as follows:
