Scheduling Notice of Availability for Formal Mediation Session

Please remember that mediation does not work if one or both parties have an unyielding position.

This mediation session will be scheduled using the Microsoft Teams virtual platform, unless both parties request an in-person mediation to be held at the PUC's Harrisburg Keystone Building or other PUC location in the Commonwealth such as Pittsburgh or Philadelphia. A legal assistant or the assigned mediator will send an email with additional information regarding use of the Microsoft Teams virtual platform.

The time slots in the morning are for 2.5-hour mediation sessions, and the afternoon times are for 3-hour sessions.
