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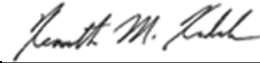

**UNOPPOSED MOTION OF PENNSYLVANIA-AMERICAN WATER COMPANY
FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO RESPOND TO
THE PETITION OF ELIZABETH TOWNSHIP FOR RESCISSION OR
AMENDMENT OF THE COMMISSION’S ORDER, TEMPORARY RATE
FREEZE, AND NUNC PRO TUNC RELIEF**

Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15, Pennsylvania-American Water Company (“PAWC” or the “Company”) hereby moves for a 7-day extension of the time period to respond to the Petition of Elizabeth Township for Rescission or Amendment of the Commission’s Order, Temporary Rate Freeze, and Nunc Pro Tunc Relief (the “Petition”) filed in the above-referenced docket on September 14, 2026. Under 52 Pa. Code § 5.572, PAWC’s answer to the Petition is due on September 24, 2026. With the requested 7-day extension, answers to the Petition would be due on October 1, 2026. This limited extension is not opposed by Elizabeth Township and will permit PAWC and Elizabeth Township additional time to engage in settlement discussions to address issues raised in the Petition.

**I. UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO RESPOND
TO THE PETITION**

1. This case was initiated on November 14, 2025, when PAWC filed Supplement No. 58 to Tariff Water – PA P.U.C. No. 5 (“Tariff No. 5”) and Supplement

No. 61 to Tariff Wastewater PA P.U.C. No. 16 (“Tariff No. 16”) with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”).

2. By Orders issued December 5, 2025, the Commission instituted a formal investigation to determine the lawfulness, justness and reasonableness of PAWC’s existing and proposed rates, rules and regulations. Accordingly, Tariff Nos. 5 and 16 were suspended by operation of law until August 13, 2026. This matter was subsequently assigned to Administrative Law Judges Jeffrey A. Watson and Emily I. Devoe (the “ALJs”) for purposes of conducting hearings and issuing a recommended decision.

3. In addition to the Commission’s Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement, several parties participated actively in this proceeding: the Office of Consumer Advocate, the Office of Small Business Advocate, Cleveland-Cliffs Steel, the Coalition for Affordable Utility Services and Energy Efficiency in Pennsylvania, the Exeter Township School District, and Victory Brewing Company.

4. After the submission of testimony, the conduct of public hearings and evidentiary hearings, and the submission of Main and Reply Briefs, the ALJs issued a Recommended Decision on May 15, 2026. On July 27, 2026, the Commission entered an order approving, among other things, water and wastewater revenue increases for PAWC.

5. On July 31, 2026, PAWC filed its compliance water and wastewater tariffs. On August 13, 2026, the Commission approved the compliance tariffs.

6. On September 14, 2026, Elizabeth Township filed the Petition.

7. Consistent with the Commission’s policy promoting settlements (52 Pa. Code § 5.231), PAWC and Elizabeth Township are actively engaged in discussions in an effort to address the issues raised in the Petition.

8. The requested extension would facilitate further discussions between PAWC and Elizabeth Township before additional Commission resources are expended on this matter.

9. Elizabeth Township has authorized PAWC to represent that it does not oppose the requested extension.

10. PAWC submits that the facilitation of further discussions with Elizabeth Township and the non-opposition of Elizabeth Township to this request demonstrate good cause as required by 52 Pa. Code § 1.15 for an extension of time to be granted.

II. CONCLUSION

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated above, the Company respectfully requests that the Commission grant this unopposed Motion and extend the response period to the Petition 7 days to October 1, 2026.
