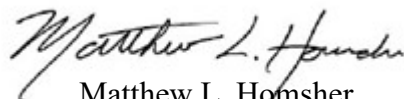
Due to timing constraints of the Technical Conference, a limit to the number of panelists may be necessary. Interested parties who want to apply to become a panelist may do so by filling out an Application on the Commission's website at <https://www.puc.pa.gov/> or downloading and submitting the Application to CLCATechConference@pa.gov no later than October 14, 2026. A court reporter will be present at the Technical Conference and panelists will be sworn in.

As part of the educational and informative process, Commissioners will pose questions to the panelists and will engage the panelists in discussions related to large computational load cost allocation in Pennsylvania. Initial conference comments will be accepted until November 13, 2026. Comments must be eFiled with the Secretary of the Commission by opening an eFiling account through the Commission's website and accepting eservice at <https://www.puc.pa.gov/filing-resources/efiling/>.

Questions from the audience during the Technical Conference will not be permitted. However, written reply comments will be accepted from members of the public. Post-conference comments must be eFiled with the Secretary of the Commission on or before December 18, 2026 at 4:30 p.m. All comments will be posted on the Commission's website.
