Unopposed Motion of Pennsylvania-American Water Company for an
Extension of Time to Respond to the Petition of Elizabeth Township for
Rescission or Amendment of the Commission's Order, Temporary Rate
Freeze, and Nunc.Pro.Tunc Relief.

TO ALL PARTIES:

This matter involves the Petition for Rescission or Amendment of the
Commission's Order, Temporary Rate Freeze, and Nunc.Pro.Tunc Relief (Petition) filed by
Elizabeth Township (Township) on September 14, 2026. It pertains to the Commission's
Opinion and Order entered July 27, 2026, authorizing an annual revenue increase for
Pennsylvania-American Water Company (PAWC) for its water and wastewater operations.
Under 52 Pa. Code § 5.572, PAWC's Answer to the Petition is due on September 24, 2026.

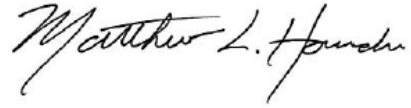
On September 22, 2026, PAWC filed an Unopposed Motion for an Extension
of Time to Respond to the Petition (Motion). PAWC submitted its Motion pursuant to
52 Pa. Code § 1.15 and requests a 7-day extension of time to respond to the Petition. For
the reasons discussed below, the Commission shall grant the Motion.

In its Motion, PAWC submits that consistent with the Commission's policy
promoting settlements under 52 Pa. Code § 5.231, PAWC and the Township are actively
engaged in discussions to address the issues raised in the Petition. According to PAWC,
the requested extension would facilitate further discussions between PAWC and the
Township before additional Commission resources are expended on this matter.
Additionally, PAWC asserts that the Township has authorized PAWC to represent that it
does not oppose the requested extension.

In light of the ongoing discussions between the Parties and the lack of
opposition to the Motion, the Commission agrees that PAWC has demonstrated good

cause for an extension of time to answer the Petition. Accordingly, the answer period for the pending Petition is hereby extended seven days until October 1, 2026.
