

**DAMAGE PREVENTION-
▶ ONE CALL
ENFORCEMENT under
ACT 50 of 2017**

AVR = Alleged Violation Report

- Facility Owners & Designers - must report within 30 business days when a line strike results in damages of more than \$2,500, or if the same excavator has already hit one of the facility owner's lines within the past 6 months.
- Excavators & Project Owners - must report within 10 business days any time a line is hit.

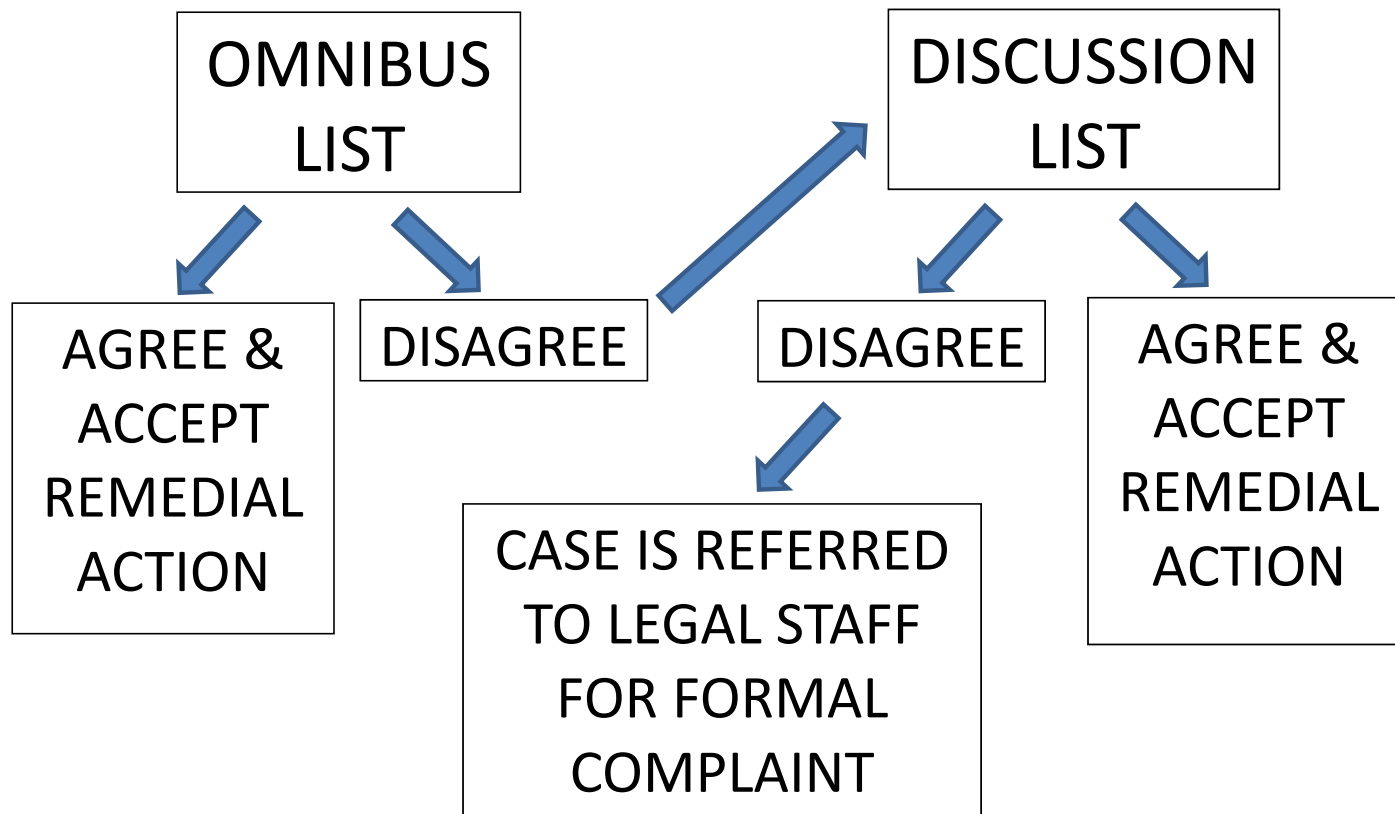

The Damage Prevention Committee (DPC)

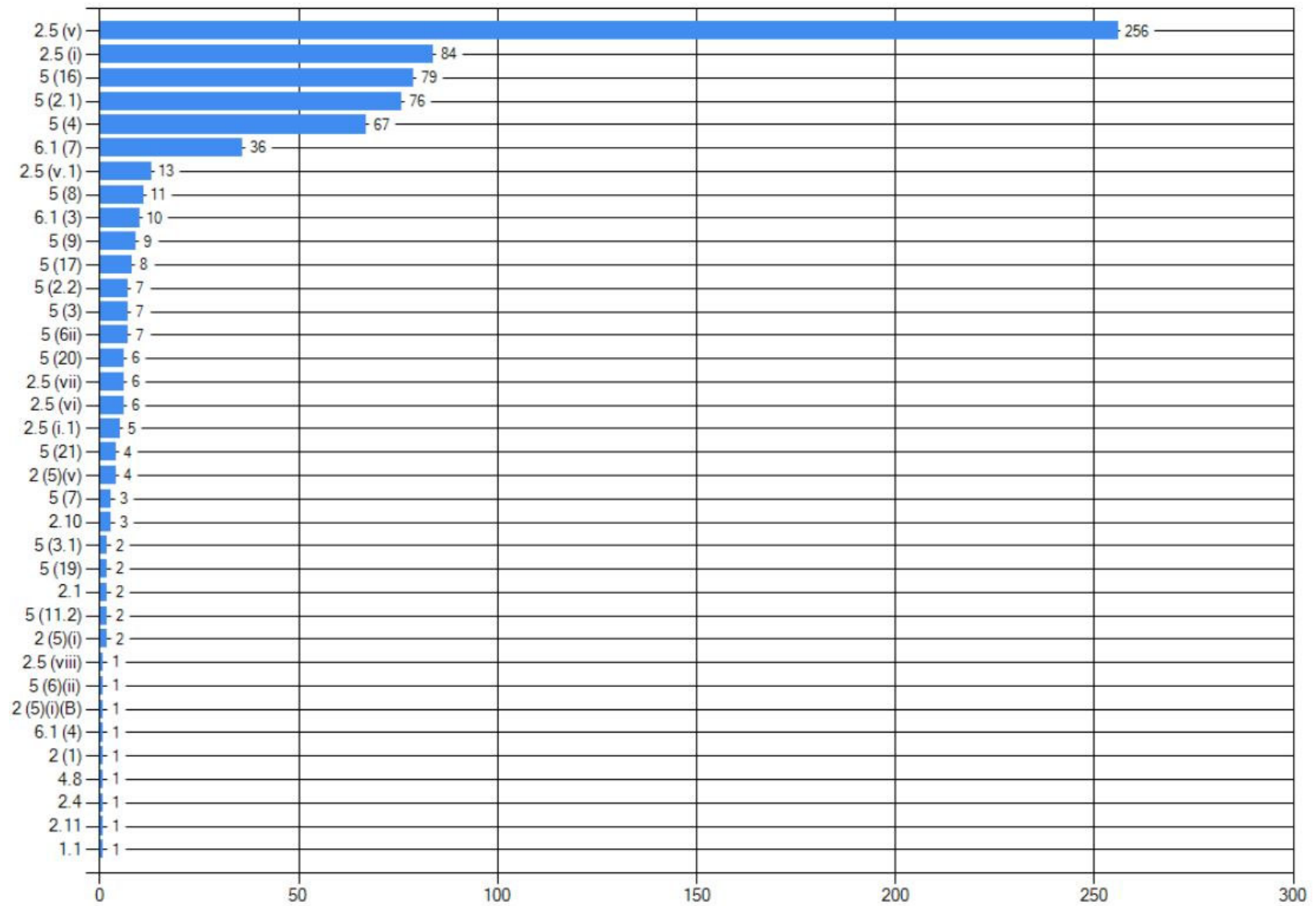




What is the violation the DPC has cited most frequently?

Hint: The section applies to facility owners.

Answer: Section 2(5)(v) - To respond to all notices through the One Call System, provided the request is made in the time frame set forth under this act.



What can facility owners do to avoid receiving an invitation to a DPC meeting?

- Respond to tickets through the POCS
- Take photos of mark-outs before excavation begins
- Respond when contacted by a Damage Prevention Investigator
- If you are a project owner, ensure final design is complete
